

PRAYER CALL 2/24/23 - LOUISIANA

CLAY NASH: All right. It's Friday. It's 2:22 ET and we are on the Victory From His Promises call. We are going to be praying, decreeing, and declaring over the state of Louisiana today. It is going to be a great finish to our first week of praying for all 50 states. Thank you, thank you, thank you, God bless you for being on these calls. The hosts, I want to tell you, the calls are getting stronger every day. By the time that we finish in April, all 50 states and who knows what God might add after that. But by the time we finish that, it is going to be a tremendous, tremendous time. And so anyway I just bless all of you for your faithfulness, and I bless today's call. Remember on Monday we will be praying for the state of Mississippi; Tuesday night at 9:00 PM Eastern, we will be praying for the state of Tennessee; on Wednesday we will be praying for North Carolina; on Thursday for Michigan; and on Friday for New Jersey. Remember all calls are at 2:22 ET Monday, Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday but our Tuesday call is at 9:00 PM at night. That is Eastern time. We are still working; graphics is not done. Coming up April 20-22, we are going to be hosting the Josiah Company Gathering. It is going to be held in Conway, Arkansas. That's not far from Little Rock. If you are going to fly in for this, you can do so. Fly into Little Rock and it is only about a 30 minute drive, if that much, up to where the facility is, lots of hotels. We are working to get all that arranged. We are trying to get it out to you. We are working as hard as we can and we will do so very, very quickly. Hoping that the graphics guy gets it finished up today. It's going to be a great call. We are going to go to Timothy Carscadden there in Louisiana and he has arranged for some guests to come on that are very key people in the state of Louisiana. So Timothy, I want to turn it over to you today and let you bring your guests on and then I have an intercessor, Susan Cordell, that I am going to ask at the end of the call to close us out in prayer. Father, I bless today's call over Louisiana. We thank you for the great things you are doing in Louisiana but not only that, Father, we thank you for the great things you are doing through Louisiana in the nation. So Father put a wind in our words, put a powerful authority upon our declarations and decrees and Father bring forth your will in Louisiana even as it is in Heaven. Do so in Yeshua's name. Timothy, it's all yours.

TIMOTHY CARSCADDEN: Thank you Clay and to all those who are on the call today. Thank you so much for standing with us for our state, Louisiana today and I will have a special guest on in just a minute. Just to give you all some foundation of where we are as a state; Louisiana is well known obviously for the Louisiana Purchase and we are different in so many different ways. The French culture, we don't do counties, we do parishes. There is such a uniqueness about our state. We have been the least in so many areas but through the grace of God there has been some major transformation I would say in the last 15 years especially. Our guest today will be a big part of that and God has really given us a voice in the nation even though we are a small state and we seem insignificant in some ways. The greatest prophetic word over Louisiana that I entered into when I moved here from Texas was that we would be a mouthpiece for the nation at the mouth of the Mississippi would be a key part of that and that is beginning to happen in such a great way through some of the leaders who have been raised up in Louisiana that are speaking into the nation now and the Republican party even today;

we have two of the top leaders in the Republican party, Steve Scalise; he is the number 2 Republican in the nation and then Mike Johnson, our Congressman, my Congressman, is number 4 in the nation as far as leadership of the Republican party and they're valued. We know them, we know them well. They are believers in the Lord and they believe in the prophetic. They believe in the encounters of God speaking to them and then speaking into the nation. We are so thankful for that. We tried to get their office on the call today but there was a death in the family and it wasn't allowed to happen but I just want to start with that and I want to give a prophetic word. Clay asked me to pray and get a word for Louisiana. This is easy for me because I love this state so much and have a big role in it. I want to prophesy that and then introduce our guest. This is what I heard when I prayed for Louisiana. The Lord said, "Louisiana you are in a window of time to enter into the fullness of your purpose in the nation and in the earth. Your call to legislate in the heavenlies is going to be empowered in greater measure and the voice of the Lord's strategies will be released through you. The Lord says, "The hindrances of your resources and gifts are going to be removed and the sons of light will arise and shine." I saw former words that were over you will be reignited as the times will require your purpose to be active. The last thing I heard was, "You will be used to explore and remove high levels of corruption in the nation in the coming season. The strategy and this is what I heard. The strategy of Wilberforce to overcome evil with good will be your portion." And I believe that's the portion we are about to walk into as Louisiana and I pray that and I speak that over our state and for this state to rise up in this hour and to fulfill its mandate in America as well as in its borders in this day. In Jesus name. Amen

CLAY NASH: Hey Timothy, Timothy, Yes Go ahead. Clay: As you were speaking, even about the time you talked about previous words, I heard the Lord say to me I prophesied a couple of years ago, it was in July, maybe 3 years ago now when Chuck and Dutch were there in Baton Rouge and I released a word at that time and I just heard it again, "that the days of the Sauls, like King Saul, the days of the Sauls troubling Louisiana are over. That the new army and the new leadership that is rising in the state of Louisiana are not going to be troubled by the Sauls. They are not going to get into the old ways but they are going to bring forth the new ways at this time. So get ready for the troubling to turn and it will now come upon the religious structures, the Sauls that man has put in place and it will begin to tear it down", says the Lord. Go ahead Timothy.

Timothy Carscadden: Wow, that's a very accurate word and I think Jean will agree with that. Let me introduce our guest. That's powerful Clay. I had forgotten you had given that word. Our guest today is Jean Mills. Jean is over at Louisiana Family Forum which is a chapter of Focus On The Family here in Louisiana. He is also a minister. We have been friends for a long time. We worked together in Louisiana. We traveled together to Israel once with APAC and he has a heart for what God is doing in Louisiana. When I think of Louisiana politics and who can move the needle the most, this ministry that Jean leads is probably the number one ministry in Louisiana that has moved the needle in Louisiana to the right conservative moral family values. They have done so much in their work and he has a tremendous network of pastors. We get calls on any legislation that is, you know, unbiblical, any issue that would hurt our state. We

get calls and he is able to engage numerous pastors. I don't know how many. He can tell you that. And we get on our calls and we get with our legislators and literally put the Holy Ghost pressure on our politicians to do the right thing and that they have done for the most part. We have had a rough eight years, we had a liberal Democrat governor and we have elections this year. This is a critical year for us as a state and Jean has been a tremendous leader and he loves the Lord with all his heart so I asked him to give the landscape of Louisiana today and where we are going and what we need prayer for and then pray over you as a listened and pray for us in Louisiana today. So Gene, thanks for joining us today. I know he is a very busy man that jumped on here with us. So why don't you take it away.

Gene Mills: Thank you Pastor Tim. Can you all hear me?

Tim: Yes we can.

Gene Mills: Well I just wanted to let you all know that I am grateful for your prayers for my great state. We are honored that people from around the country are aiming their influence at Heaven and asking for God's favor over the state of Louisiana. I think there is a great deal of misunderstanding about Louisiana. Obviously, we have the French culture, we have the Spanish influence, we have the years of different leadership that's kind of melted into a cultural pot. Some call it a gumbo of different nationalities and leaderships and different propensities in the past that we've held onto. Some of them have been very favorable. We have a very parochial view of family. Family is still very important. Sixty percent of most of Louisianians still live within sixty miles of where they were born. They are very connected to their grandparents and their great-grandparents. The legacy that comes with that is of great value. We have a deep and abiding Catholic presence, particularly in Acadiana, the French portions and the German settlements of Louisiana, south of the interstate in the coastal regions which take a very favorable view of marriage and a reverence for God. I was raised Catholic and in 1981, I was saved in a movie theater watching "Chariots of Fire" and the Spirit of God opened my eyes. I had a legislator stop and ask me one time; he said, "I thought you were raised Catholic?" He said, "What happened to you?" I said, "I was. I got excited about everything ya'll taught me and I just go hungry for more!" And I think that really encapsulates the heart of Louisiana. When a Believer is on fire in Louisiana, they live large, they play hard, they pray hard, and they believe God for big things. And we believe the state of Louisiana has Kingdom implications on the rest of the world. Louisiana has got, as Pastor Tim has just said, one of the most powerful representations in the US Congress. And it's not just Mike Johnson who used to carry my bags when he was in law school. And when I launched the Family Forum, I slept on his floor at his house. We believe in deep and abiding relationships that last a long time. By the way, that's what covenant people do. They communicate and cooperate in this lifetime and they will continue to do so in eternity. Scalise believes the same thing. When Steve Scalise was shot, I went to his emergency room and prayed for him and led a team of intercessors to pray over his life for God to preserve him. There's Garrett Graves who Kevin McCarthy has just said is personally responsible for putting together the coalition to make him Speaker of the House. So Garrett has risen into that role. And then there's possibly the most quoted man in America, John Kennedy in the US Senate who has a way and almost like a

country bumpkin to say the obvious but to break through all the red tape and to capture a message that goes out to the world. Louisiana is not a poor state. We're overflowing with natural resources. We've been called at times "the rice, soybean, sweet potato and cotton capital of the world". We're rich in oil and gas. We're rich in aquaculture and agriculture. We have deep water international ports that can go anywhere in the world. The mighty Mississippi River drains seventy percent of Northern America. One third of the United States Continental territories came and are made up of the old Louisiana Purchase. We've invested in yawl. It's only appropriate that we continue to petition God to invest in this little piece land that runs in the coastal territories but who it's been prophesied over that the mouth of that river, the mouth of the mighty Mississippi, where numerous dysplasias have occurred; the slaves came from Hatti, Novoscoians, and the Pershakadian's came down the Mississippi, to the Mississippi River and we were told on numerous occasions that the next great awakening would flow from the mouth of the river. Then it would go upstream into the heartland and it would touch this nation in this world for Jesus Christ. We are not a poor state. We're poor stewardship, we are poor at stewardship and we've been under poor management. Our largest cities, New Orleans, Baton Rouge, and Shreveport have become a haven for crime, for drugs, for gangs, for unemployment. New Orleans is in the news today because it's responsible for five percent of the mass shootings in the United States. Their Mayor, LaToya Cantrell, is a walking conflict of interest. In a recall petition that's been submitted for her removal - it's never been done before in the history of Louisiana. Fifty thousand registered voters who voted her into office, I might add, filed the petition to have her removed and right now they are certifying that petition. And a George Soros backed District Attorney is equally alarming and conflicting. New Orleans has become ungovernable. A battle is brewing over our public libraries right now in Louisiana. The Library Association, which is a very liberal group that headed by the American Library Association, headed by a liberal feminist, who has Marxist ideas and a hundred million dollar budget believes that they have a right in the public libraries to place inappropriate material in the reach of minors. In four parishes, we generated a war of sorts, the beginnings of a battle because we've moved forward. And parents have shown up at these control board organizations and said there's no appropriate way to introduce inappropriate material to a minor and in each case they fought back and said, "Notwithstanding your standards, we're going to continue to do what our national office tells us." The opposition is growing. Our governor, John Bel Edwards, the pro-life second amendment army ranger, who on his first day of office closed the doors of Forum for Equality, a liberal left-wing LGBT organization, and hired their staff to work on his fourth floor, says of the Library system, "I know of no conflict that exist anywhere in the libraries right now." Of course he thought it was appropriate to introduce a welcome sign over the little girls restrooms and in women's sports and it was our network that said, "This is incomprehensible and we're not going to allow it to stand." Pastor Tim mentioned that we've made some impact. We've amended the constitution to define marriage as one man and one woman. We came close to elevating religious liberty to a protected category but for one of those ole Sauls that we just talked about, we stopped it in the final minutes and we got another measure that's coming. And right now there's a legislative session that's about to begin in about thirty days and in that legislative session, the Louisiana Family Forum, a twenty five year old organization that I have, that's affiliated with Focus on the Family, and

Family Research Council, which has been called the most powerful lobby at the capital, has three main imperatives. Number 1 - To keep Louisiana abortion free. Our life issue - We prohibit abortions throughout all nine months of pregnancy right now. There are no exceptions. They say there's an exception for the life of the mother but that's not really an exception. That's called "medical treatment", not for the purpose of abortion, for the purpose of keeping the mother alive. The second imperative is to preserve liberty. We're going on notice in the Constitution to say that the government has no authority to forbid what God commands or command what God forbids by closing churches during emergency orders. And we're in the process of putting together the resources, the capital, and the Pastors and their influence to fight the battle that says, "You're not going to shut us down again." And the third area will be the Library - to tell the American Library Association, "You are publicly funded and you operate in Louisiana at our good pleasure and will be made accountable." Additionally, what's coming is a governor's race. In October or November we'll have what we call a "Jungle Primary". Unlike other states, we have off-year elections so it seems like we're always in an election cycle and in this case we don't have an election for the Democrat candidate and the Republican candidate like we do at a national level. We have a "Jungle Primary" where you may have eight, ten, or twelve candidates vying for the top two positions so that they might run it all. The leader in that race right now is our Attorney General and a friend of the Louisiana Family Forum and a friend of mine. He's raised over five million dollars and put another three million in political action committees and it is said that he is the front runner. In a near second is our Treasurer, John Shroder who is also a friend of ours. We work to make certain that these guys know that we care about their soul as well as our state. So our ministry is the Ministry of Proximity, our mission field is the place where decisions are made, and we believe darkness deserves as much light as we can possible bring it. And so we're called to the mission field of government so that we can show those that serve in decision making capacities, persuasive evidence of the things that we count as dear and hold as important. There's an outsider whose name is Hunter Lundy, who's running as an independent, who's a self-professed Believer, he's the old attorney who argued the Marvin Gormon birth of Jimmy Swaggart, a case back in the early 90's. He's well known and well funded and then there'll be a Democrat contender - likely Shawn Wilson who will almost automatically get thirty percent of the vote because of the large African-American population in the state of Louisiana. The prayer that I have for the state can for you is to understand we're not a poor people. We're a very resilient people. We've just been poorly managed. We're guilty of poor stewardship. My prayer is found in Proverbs 8:12 that God would take and He would bestow upon the state of Louisiana - in 8:12 it says, "I wisdom," and we need God's wisdom. And we know wisdom flows from His Throne, "dwell with prudence." Prudence teacher is government. Wisdom's teacher is God but prudences' teacher is government. "I Wisdom dwell with prudence and together by knowledge." Knowledge's teacher is failure. Failure is to be a teacher but not a constant companion and in Louisiana we've made her our companion. "I Wisdom, dwell with prudence and together by knowledge seek out witty inventions." Witty invention is a creative solution that brings joy, that brings hope, that brings life and that answers the problems over our state. And what we need is to move Louisiana out of the "survivors" category and into the "thrivers" category. And it can happen with the right leader because we have a resilient people,

we have great sources, and we have a great opportunity before us. And we believe that that battle is fully engaged. The governors' race will portend what the next four or eight years look like. Our job at the Family Forum is much more difficult when we have somebody like John Bel who says, "I don't need the churches, I have access to some of my black church friends. When some of these other evangelical Baptist and Catholic churches; they don't really need to seat at the table. They're already over represented." And it's been very difficult to have influence. We fight mostly defensive battles when we have a Democrat in office. When there's a Republican in office, there's a great opportunity for hope and for reform and for change. We believe there's Kingdom imperatives over what's next and we need to value the things that Heaven treasures and embrace the Father's heart. So, my prayer for Louisiana will be, "Heavenly Father, we bow before Your Throne and I join with my brother's and sister's from around the country and around the world. We pray that Your grace and favor will move upon this land again. Thank You for Your promises that a revival will flow from the mouth of this river and it will go into the Heartland and it would open blind eyes, open prison doors and set the captives free, that it would set aright what the enemy has distorted and stolen, that it would return to the rightful owners the things that are rightfully theirs and the things that the canker worm has eaten and the armies has taken, that You would restore and make Louisiana a bright light again. Already You've lit up pulpits around the country. Somebody mentioned Conway, Arkansas. My good friend Rick Biset pastors in Conway, Arkansas. We cut our teeth in ministry together. Chris Hodges and I went to high school together and the Church of the Highlands is touching the inland and touching this nation. I pray that our pulpits would become a flame of fire as Your ministers are set on fire with the Holy Spirit. Holy Spirit, lead us to the place that Father's prepared. May it be a place of excellence and integrity, of breakthrough and opportunity, of taking out the old and bringing in the new, ushering in the things that You treasure and that move the Heavenly Father's heart. Open our eyes to see. Make our ears attentive to hear and cause our hearts to embrace those things that You value and lead us to the place of breakthrough. Give us the integrity that's necessary to carry a difficult message in a generation that doesn't embrace that message and actively doubts it. Help us to make impacts at the legislature, at the city council, before school boards and before library control boards. Give us Your talking points and the grace and the favor to communicate Your Word. To the end that You be glorified, Your Kingdom expanded, Your Name made well known and Your Word made unavoidable. In Jesus Name we pray." Thank you, Jean. I'll turn it back to Clay. Thank you so much.

Clay Nash: Alright, thank you for that. We've got plenty of resources, artillery to battle with with all of that so we will continue to do so. I'm going to call on Pat. I want you to go next so release those things that are in your heart.

Pat McManus: Thank you Clay, for the opportunity with everyone. I want to just uh, listening to what the gentleman just said there a minute ago just gives you a greater enthusiasm to press forward to see the Kingdom of God advance in that state, in the states in our United States as a whole. And I kept hearing this morning as I began to focus on Louisiana ... I heard these two words: "A reformer state." I kept hearing that word. "Reformer state". A fresh wave of Glory is about to be revealed and the dry bones

are coming to life and God has positioned you as Acts 3, at a “right time gate”. Father, we thank You that You are establishing the foundational expression of Your heart in the state of Louisiana. That Father, the dry bones are coming to life into a whole new paradigm to see the glory of God to be revealed upon our land. That Father, You are setting those with a clear sound as You’re bringing the generations together to establish a reforming state, or a state that truly brings reformation and awakening to the land. That, Father, You are igniting that region for the glory and for the expression and for the power and the demonstration of Your Name. Father, we thank You that there is a positioning where a “right kind gate” is being established that will cause the miraculous to be seen and the power of Your Name known. So, Father, as You declared in ‘03, that You are removing the veil so Father, let there be a releasing of a sound that will cause the clear expression that will shake everything that that which needs to be realigned as the dry bones come together and the wind of Holy Spirit blows as the glory of God is revealed that will cause a reformation to be established and will lead the way for transformation for our nation. So, Father, we thank You for what You are doing. We thank You for the “right time gates” You are establishing and the movement of Your hand upon that land. We give You honor and praise in Jesus Name. Amen and amen!

Clay Nash: Alright, Pat. Thank you for those declarations and decrees. Regina, there in Missouri, what’s in your heart?

Regina Shank: Well, I just kept thinking when I was praying for Louisiana about John 5 and it’s about the man who was paralyzed and he lay there in front of the pool for thirty eight years with his infirmity. And Jesus came to him and said, “Do you want to get well?” And He spoke to him and said, “Rise, take up your bed and walk.” And the thirty eight years kept jumping out to me and so I looked up thirty eight years in regards to Louisiana and I ran into Malcome Alexander. He was twenty years old and he was wrongfully convicted of rape and he served a thirty eight year sentence in at the prison there but he did not commit the crime. And I began to look up what the word “Malcome” meant and it means “dove” in Latin. And I was just putting all this together because I felt like the Holy Spirit was speaking to me about Louisiana. And so I just want to decree into that. Lord, I thank You right now that what Louisiana has been wrongfully accused of, Lord, You would exonerate that state. And You will begin to bring them out of any kind of prisons that have tried to capture them. And Lord, we decree over for the state of Louisiana, Lord, Louisiana will be as the pool of Bethesda. Louisiana will be the place where those who are sick and those who are dying will come to the “pool of the Lord” and that pool is called “House of Mercy”. And so Lord, we call forth all of the people in Louisiana to come to the House of Mercy, to come to the House of the Fisherman, to come to the house of the Way-maker, to recognize that the dove can no longer be held captive in the prison of religion. That the dove can no longer be held captive in the prison of unbelief but the dove will be released to hover over Louisiana and began to bring forth the freedom that needs to happen in that state. And so Lord, we thank You that today is the day that this is the day we pray for that state and we say to that state, “You’ve been wrongly accused and you’ve been held captive by religion.” And we say “Today you are coming out in the Name of Jesus.” Also, in this story, when he was put in prison he had a two year old son and when he got out his son was forty years old.

And Lord, we thank You today that You are going to bring forth a generation, a generation who've been waiting for the prisoner to be released, the generation who've been looking for power in the Body of Christ rather than power in witchcraft and power in vudu, and power in the dark side. But they are looking for that power, God, that only You can release into Your churches and into the parishes of that state. Lord, we thank You for that. Lord, and we know that the word parish comes from a parish that even children whose last name is Parish are those who have been abandoned. And Lord, we say right now, "that the abandoned children, those who have been left to their own devices will now come forth." That generation that's waiting for the freedom is going to have what You called them to have and they're going to stand and they're going to say, "The Lord, who is God and they're going to turn their backs on the darkness, and turn their backs on the powerless church and begin to step in to the power of revival that's going to happen with that generation." So, Lord, we call forth Louisiana into her steadfast faith and into the power of the dove that is released now in Jesus Name. Amen

Clay Nash: Amen, Regina. Thank you for those strong declarations and decrees. Dwain Miller, there in Little Rock, Arkansas, good to have you on with us today. What's in your heart, sir?

Dwain Miller: Clay, I especially wanted to be on today with Louisiana at the forefront because I spent a quarter of a century on the Louisiana border at El Dorado, Arkansas pastoring. And I had the great privilege, most humble privilege to have Dr. Marvin Goreman the last ten years of his life as a mentor as I was moving a traditional southern Baptist church into a Spirit filled Word of Faith charismatic church. And Dr. Goreman had a open invitation at Crosslife Church in El Dorado. As a matter of fact, the last miracle God performed by his hand was at the altar at Crosslife Church on a Wednesday night whenever he laid hands on my youth pastor's son who had a broken leg and the young man took the cast off his leg and ran around the building completely healed. Dr. Goreman was a passionate revivalist in this nation with signs, wonders and miracles accompanying his ministry. And if I could take this moment of personal privilege to just share something he shared with me and our congregation when we first brought him to El Dorado, sitting in his study in New Orleans at the Assembly of God church there, in 1983, I think it was. He had an open vision and in this open vision, he saw Ohio and this accompanies the word already given by our brother there in Louisiana. He saw a fire begin to burn in the mouth of the Mississippi and he knew it was the fire of Glory, the fire of Revival and it went up through Louisiana into central Arkansas. It went through El Dorado, which was Dr. Goreman's home area. He was raised in that part of Arkansas - went into Little Rock in central Arkansas. Then it turned to the northwest and went up through northwest Arkansas into Tulsa, Oklahoma City, turned and came south to Dallas, made its way to south Texas and then reconnected in southern Louisiana. It was a mighty ring of fire of revival and glory that the Lord showed him would touch the nation but that would be the very center piece of how it would happen. And looking back on that map - we got a map and he showed me how that ring of glory would touch that part of America and touch the nation. Clay, it was interesting because that ring, that fire went straight up through Little Rock, straight up to now what I

know is your property in north central Arkansas. I didn't know that you had that - maybe you didn't have the property back then but this has been fifteen years ago that he shared this vision. But it went straight through the mouth of the Mississippi through central Arkansas, north central Arkansas, cut across southern south western Missouri into Oklahoma, touching those major regions and the Lord explained to him that there would be some in all denominations touched. And God said to him, especially the Baptist would be touched by my glory and Dr. Goreman said, - he asked the Lord why the Baptist and He said, "because they have been true to my Word." And we don't have time to get into the history of the outpouring of Holy Spirit in America with the evidence of Tongues and the evidence so forth but it was accompanied by many of the things in Dr. Goreman's life. So, I just wanted to add that vision and that prophetic word. There were many many more visions and dreams and prophetic words that he offered to accompany this visitation from God but I come into agreement with Dr. Goreman's vision and we say, "the time is now." We declare from Your Word, Lord, that Your spirit shall be poured out on all flesh in the United States of America. We decree from that vision that You will touch the Catholic, the Episcopalian, Methodist, the Baptist, the Assembly of God, the Church of God, the Pentecostal - that You will root out the religious spirits that have been in control and there will be remnants, there will be those who rise up as Ekklesias, out of these groups and touched by the Holy Ghost. And that what You are doing in the campuses of America will touch the school campuses - the highschoools and the middle school, Junior highs, and elementaries and that these will spill over into the Church and spill over into the political world. Lord, I pray right now as I said Sunday in our meeting at church - I prophesied that men of God will be invited into the houses of legislation, the representatives and the senates in states and open with prayer and the Glory will fall. Lord, You've given me the privilege of praying the opening session of the senate in Arkansas next week. We declare the Glory of God will consume that place, the power of God will fall, men and women's hearts will be changed and touched by the very mention of the name of Jesus. Lord, we thank You that as Dutch has prophesied and he has proclaimed that the spiritual will be awakened first and then political will be transformed and reformation, reformation will come to this nation because of Your Name, Your Word, Your Glory and because of the sacrificial seeds sown by our brother there in Louisiana at this Family Forum and others that have done like work in America - they've sacrificed, they've labored, seeds have been sown, now abortion has been cut off from this nation. But Lord we say that the other blights on this nation too shall be removed by the power of Your Word and the Presence of Holy God. Lord, we thank You for what You're doing in Louisiana. We pray for Pastor Tim in Shreveport, a place near to my heart where I have relatives that live where I went to bible college. But I pray right now that the Glory fall on Shreveport, and the Baybex city, move into those casinos, those river boats, transform lives, transform people with a mighty wave of Glory. I pray that people will come to repentance and will seek Your face and I thank You Lord, that Louisiana is going to set the tone for America in the name of reformation. I pray this in Yeshua's Name. Amen.

Clay Nash: Alright, thank you Dwain for that. I appreciate it. Timothy, we've got a caller that has come on that I'm going to have you introduce. I appreciate this next person that you'll hear speaking. Contact was made through someone that is connected to me.

They were on the call so I sent an invitation for them to come and they have done so. So, Timothy, introduce them.

Timothy: Sure, thank you Clay. And some of ya'll, I think we've talked about it on our prayer call that is here in Shreveport we just had a mayor's election in December and Tom Arceneaux was the gentleman, he's in our congregation, his wife Elizabeth - we've been walking together for twenty five plus years. When the Lord together a supernatural miracle of the mayorship in Shreveport. We are a very Democratic controlled community. No Republican has got more than thirty five percent of the vote from the last about twenty years and we won this election going away in the runoff and Elizabeth and I, his wife, have been working in intercession around the world. We've traveled together in South Africa and many other places together praying for America, praying for the nations and she's a true intercessor. Look up "intercessor" in the dictionary, her picture is right there. She just loves to pray and so we've asked her to pray today for Louisiana. So, Elizabeth, thanks for joining us and just lead us out in prayer what you'd like to pray over Louisiana today.

Elizabeth Arceneaux: I want to first thank you, thank all of you for the invitation. It's a real honor, a privilege to be on this call. I was sent a text and we just got on and was listening and started to pray and agree with these incredible prayers and prophetic words that God is pouring out. I'm just so very humbled and honored to be a part of this call and yes, I'm just so excited to hear the unity of the coming together of the prayer and humbled all of the people, 723 on this call that are praying specifically for Louisiana, Shreveport, all the government areas. Pastor Tim, my pastor, said that this was a real miracle for us to even step in this place. We've only been in office since - we came into office 10:45 AM on December 31st. So we're still in the honeymoon stage. We started to walk things out and had a shooting every four days since we've been in office. So, we have been in prayer and the prophecy about the dry bones, I think that brother Pat spoke about that. Actually the word the Lord had given my husband, the mayor on the dry bones, Ezekiel 37 and that's been his sort of his message he's been speaking over Louisiana and that he had said that everybody has a place at the table. There's been a real expectancy and a hope already birthed in Shreveport and I just have been thanking everybody for the prayers. And I just want to lay down my life, Father. I am saying "yes and amen" to all that has been prayed from your heart over Shreveport. Lord, I thank You, Father God that this expectation and hope that You're pouring out, Father God, that the Church is rising up, their voice is being heard, they're coming together, these dry bones are coming together. Father God, the sinews and the life and the breath into each one. We thank You, Father, even for that sound that was released years ago, that sound of Prophet Chuck Pierce had released and the prophets and the apostles that have come to Shreveport, that have come to Louisiana and releasing it. Father, that You are even bringing those words together. That word that has said wrapped around Shreveport like a prayer shawl over Shreveport by the word that's been over Louisiana that has been wrapped around, Father. I thank You, Father God, that is bound to her now, Father God, that she will step into that, Father. All those words that have been prayed, Father God and prophesied. We thank You, Father for the intercessor. We thank You, Father God for the wombs being pregnant with Your Word, Father God that

they will pour forth and birth, Father God, through that mouth of the Mississippi, Father God. That it will go into the land, not only from Shreveport but from all over Louisiana, Father, from Mississippi, coming up into all the states, Father. In the Name of Jesus. And I thank each and every one ... I thank You for each one on this call, Father, that is praying and prophesying that have stood and anchored in like a peg in their father's house ... anchored in there, Father God, agreeing with You, Father. And we're thanking You for Your heart to pour forth. We're thanking You, Father God, for Your Word, Father, waking up the church. I thank You for those that have gone before us, the church that Pastor Mel has said about the tassles, those that have stood, Father God, that foundation, Father God, that has been deep in the faith, deep in family, deep in those things. Father, that just a freshness, a newness to come about today, Father God and to pour forth. We thank You for the reformation. We thank You for, Father God for all that You have provided. I also want to, when he was talking about the stewardship, the poor stewardship. I want to say, Father God, and stand in the gap, Father God and repent for that poor stewardship, for not seeking You for how to steward for all that You have given us. Father, I ask for forgiveness and I repent, Father God for me and my house and for the church, Father God, for this city, for the state where we have squandered away or traded illegally and given away and not really sought Your heart on how to steward it, Father. And Father, that You would set those things in order, set those finances in order, Father. Where You have given us so much and Father, where we could be stewarding it to help others. And we thank You for the wisdom in that. We thank You for bringing us together as one in You, in the mighty Name of Jesus. I give You all the praise, all the glory. Amen. Thank you, sir.

Clay Nash: Alright. I couldn't get the mute button off. Elizabeth, thank you for that. Thank you for being spontaneous and coming on. We're going to close out in just a minute with Susan Cordell with a closing prayer, an intercessor from the Monroe area but as Elizabeth, as you were speaking - in my prophetic gifting I'm a seer and I saw a vision. In the vision, you were speaking and you had a mic in your hand and I saw the hand of God remove mic from your hand and He put a megaphone in your hand. The megaphone was huge. I'm talking about - I've seen some on top of cars before, it was a huge megaphone. And this megaphone comes with a greater mantle for these unwed mothers of that area. The Lord said, "As you unfold the new mantle, there will be a greater blueprint that you will discover inside the mantle that He is putting upon you and that megaphone represents that mantle. So, get ready, I don't want to call it a promotion but there's greater responsibility going to come to you. I feel like there's a dream that either has come or will come that's going to confirm this. But it has to do with unwed mothers. So, get ready for that.

Elizabeth Arceneaux: Thank you sir, I receive that. God's will be done, Amen.

Clay Nash: Alright. Susan Cordell, great intercessor, intercedes for Susan and I and our ministry but she also battles and has for years long with Gloria Steele there in and across the state of Louisiana. I'm going to call on you now to just close this call out in prayer and declarations that are in your heart.

Gloria Steele: I sure will. Thank you for allowing me to do this. And I so appreciate everyone that came on. Every single person gave such a huge part and it's so encouraging and just makes us ... makes me more enthusiastic than ever as Pat would say. So, Father, we thank You that the sound of the Lord, the sound of revival is arising out of Louisiana, the new sound that You said that would come out of Louisiana is coming forth. We declare it's a sound of righteousness, of worship, of purity, of the voice of the Lord scattering the enemy and shattering all cohesiveness in the enemies camp. Lord, I speak to all false structures to be disassembled and removed and thank You. The residue is being swept away. We agree with the continued shaking of every thing that needs to be shaken as well as the continued shifting that is taking place towards righteousness, towards conservative values, towards family values, towards life. We thank You for it. We decree that the legislative seats coming up for election in 2024 will be filled with godly, God fearing men and women with strong backbones who will stand for life, constitutional accuracy, and follow after Your heart and after the purposes and plans of God for this state. We call our next governor forth. We say, "Come forth, in the Name of Jesus. Be disentangled from anything or any need of disentanglement." We just speak to every seat that is to be sealed in Lt. Governor, District Attorney, State Treasurer, Attorney General. We call every elected official forth in righteousness and in holiness. Lord, let the fear of God drop on this state so that there will be such a hunger to please You and to provide a safe place for our citizens and a place of prosperity from all that You have granted and given us. I thank You, Lord, for the mother's and daddy's that are coming to the forefront and I thank You that's only going to increase as they appear in the educational system. Father, I thank You that they hold the banner of uprightness and righteousness high and that they will be strong backed and they will be respectful of authority. But Father I thank You that the disrespect for life, the disrespect and the dishonor towards families being in authority over their children has to bow in the Name of Jesus. We decree a sound economic growth throughout this land. I thank You for the discovery of new resources, new creative ways, the witty inventions, the ways to process and to mine and to tap into the new. We decree that new business, industry, medical technology is coming forth out of Louisiana. We decree that the Ekklesia is arising and increasing in revelation and pressing against complacency, confusion, division. We declare that there is unity in Louisiana. We speak the peace of God over Louisiana and all of our citizens and we declare that revival is our portion and we say revival is in our land. Father, we thank You that the prodigals are coming home and we thank You that the orphans are coming home that they might be fathered and come to a revelation of Your love. Let Louisiana become an Upper Room in Jesus Name we pray and I thank You for it. Amen.

Clay Nash: Alright! Thank you, Susan for that. And Timothy and those who in Louisiana who are listening, I heard something as she was praying. I heard the Lord say and He said to tell you to begin to declare this over the state of Louisiana that the chronos time, the kairos time and the horarios time are about to synchronize together in the state of Louisiana and the state of Louisiana would become the Gate Beautiful so that those that are lame in stewardship will no longer be lame. So, take that word, test it, and go forth with it. It's been a great call. We've had an incredible week. We'll be back here on Monday 2:22 ET. We're going to hit the state of Mississippi and we're going to

go through next week. It's going to just be a tremendous time. I bless everyone on the call.
