Clay Nash [00:00:28] Well, good evening, it's 9:00 p.m. Eastern Time, and it's a Tuesday night, and we're just a couple of days before Thanksgiving. And tonight our host is going to be on with me. We're going to just be giving thanks for what God is doing. I wanna open us in just a minute for prayer. Remember, we will be on the call tomorrow at 2:22. But on Thanksgiving Day, I just felt like the Lord nudged my heart to not have the call that day. Not that it's not important, but that 2:22 time; 1:22, 12:22 all across the nation, is a real key time when a lot of families are sitting down to dinner and, you know, consuming that turkey and enjoying good conversation, rejoicing. And so we just wanted to let everybody have the liberty to be able to to enjoy Thanksgiving together. We're going to have a great Thanksgiving here up in the mountains of Arkansas. We got our granddaughter, Hunter, with us. Picked her up on Sunday night on my way back in from Lexington and we're just excited to have her here. Well, father, we thank you for tonight's call and we thank you, Lord we're all here to... And Lord, we choose to see, and know and live in the total attitude that you are a good good Father. And we thank you that all good and perfect gifts come down from you, the father of light. So father, tonight as we share the things that are in our heart that we are thankful over, we rejoice over, we thank you, Father, that maybe there will be someone on the call or someone listening to the recording that just needs some fresh hope. So let that be imparted tonight. Lord, I start tonight's call, by telling you how thankful I am for the thousands of callers that are so faithful, so consistent to join on this call and the literally hundreds and thousands of emails that I've received giving testimony of how they've been encouraged and stirred and matured and grown. So tonight, as we {inaudible} our hearts; hearts of Thanksgiving. As we choose to see what you're doing and not focus on what the enemy is doing, Father. not that we're denying it or seeking to be foolish, but we know that you are working in the midst of every situation. So Father, let our words be strong tonight. Let them be words that will bring more than encouragement, but a stirring of passion, a stirring a focus, a stirring of release of grace that will empower the people that's on this call and hear this call to move to another level of authority. So, father, we bless you tonight. I Bless each of the hosts that have made time to be with us tonight. And Father, I bless each one of the participants that will be on adding their power of agreement, even those that listen at a later date and add their power of agreement. Those that will be praying along with us lord and rejoicing in the goodness of a God that gave us the ability to war with him and from his promises. And on behalf of heaven touching earth. So father, we bless you tonight. And we do so out of hearts of Thanksgiving and hearts of love in Yeshua's name. Betty Love, I'm calling on you first to share what's in your heart tonight?

Betty Love [00:04:31] Well, Clay, I first of all, I believe I'm going to echo everyone that's on this call. We want to thank you for your faithfulness, you and Susan and the foresight--I know you don't expect this, but we would be remiss if we didn't thank God for you and your faithfulness and hearing the Lord knowing that in 2019 we needed to take our place in the gate as a functioning Ekklesia. And I just want to thank the Lord for you and your

faithfulness, your ministry and your leadership. But also, I echo with you such Thanksgiving because I believe we've seen across this nation the merging of streams, different streams in the body of Christ, but a maturing of the Ekklesia and alignment coming together for the sake of this country and for God's plan. There is a scripture in Psalm 50:23, and I believe it will encourage those that are listening tonight or will listen. And I believe this this could be a banner scripture for where we have been 2020 and into 21', the election, everything that we've seen in this nation. But it says in Psalm 50 :23: he who sacrifices thanks offerings honors me and he prepares the way that I may show him the salvation of God. And that thank offering is a sacrifice of Thanksgiving. It's a thank offering and that word is tudah (sp?) in the Hebrew, and it actually means this: it's a type of offering that we are thanking God before we ever see the manifestation of the miracle of the promise. It is a Thanksgiving to the Lord that we're not going to consider our circumstances with our natural lives, but we're going to look through the eyes of faith at the Lord, to the Lord, our deliverer and this declaration of Thanksgiving, this sacrifice of Thanksgiving is believing God for the impossible. And when you give this kind of praise, it releases the power and wisdom of God to move on our behalf, and that is individually, corporately, territorially and generationally. And I just want to praise God for a faithful remnant that has stood across this nation, regardless of what we have seen, praising God, standing in faith, believing that he is supreme and he is able to do all things and that he is going to uphold the words that he has spoken over our nation. And again, we have seen a people that will not be moved. And as a result of that, we are all praising God for the turning that we are seeing for different states that are taking their stand; Texas and Arkansas, when Mississippi and just throughout the nation, the turning that is begun and we have not yet seen the fullness. But I am fully persuaded that God is able to do what he said he would do and he is performing his word. And so just again, the power of agreement. On another note, the Lord spoke to us in 20' to go back with our 70 day decree. But rather than posting on Facebook, he led us to do a live broadcast every day. And as things begin to heat up and shaken the nation, we stayed in that gate. A functioning Ekklesia made up of people from just about every state in the nation was up in the fourth watch every morning and going live at six o'clock, and we learned to navigate and be able to use our Facebook live and in the comment section had people actually making their decrees and that war word again, a functioning Ekklesia is still going strong every Wednesday morning, but they were faithful to join, and many on this call are a part of the war words broadcast. But they were faithful to be in the gate and stay in the gate throughout 20', throughout last year at Thanksgiving and then as we moved into 21', we shifted to one day a week, and Clay, that's when, you know, , the week we were finishing with every day or five days a week, we brought in the 222 to prayer call and that began every day. And I'm just praising God for the grace that has been upon the people that have been standing, the grace to be in the gate and keep on keeping on. And to me, that's just amazing. It's a demonstration of the Lord's power. We are continuing to see streams align in the state of Mississippi. I know Clay, I think you've shared this, but we are thankful. we were in a meeting-- ministerede in a meeting down in Wiggins, Mississippi, last Thursday evening, and we are seeing the demonstration of signs, wonders and miracles. Anyone that was in that meeting Thursday night that had chronic pain in their body, the Lord healed them on the spot. And, you know, we go back and check if we were seeing in the Lord move through the gathering there and went back to the first person. You know where

are you? No pain. it was just--here He is. We have a good, good father. He is a deliverer. He is a healer. And there are times in our lives that it's a sacrifice of praise because in the natural, it doesn't look like anything is there. But the word promises he who offers up sacrifices of Thanksgiving honors me, says the Lord, and prepares the way that I may show him the salvation of God. And I believe this is just the beginning. We are going to see the salvation of the God in the land of the living throughout our nation, from the Supreme Court to each sphere of society. So I'm just thanking the Lord for what he's doing and of course, thanking the Lord for our family. The last thing that I will say here, I'm rejoicing as a mom. I am seeing the manifestation of promises that the Lord has spoken over our lives, our family. Our daughter Anna is getting married in December, December 18th, and only bekownst to her dad and I, December 5th, two years ago, the Lord spoke to my heart. Just after the NEI conference, I was on the way home and he spoke to my heart that two years from now, you will be in a full length preparation for a wedding for Anna Love, and I had no idea and accept what the Lord said, and it's the truth. So again, I just want to say I'm thankful for the faithfulness of the Lord, the faithfulness of his people, and that he is watching over his word to perform it in our lives. Amen.

Cause, when God does it, he always does it right, but the young man that he brought into Ana's life and her into his life come from an incredible family and he's an incredible man of God. You know, Anna has a great dad and mom, but we consider her a daughter. You know, we've been around Anna a lot and pulled on her prophetic worship gifting. So we rejoice with you for that too. I had the privilege of being up with Tim Sheets, did the HUB meeting on Friday night. This doesn't always happen, but I came away from the pulpit that night. And I've been-- I just casually mentioned anintercessory group in Jonesboro, Arkansas, and through that there was a couple that had moved there from-- actually from Mississippi and been there, and they'd not connected with mature intercessors and so today had a great conversation and was able to get that connection going. So it was a very-- we're in a very significant time. Alignment. Katartizo is is taking place and these alignments are filled with the synergy of ages. And we're going to see more and more of that this next. Next year, it's going to be great. Pat, my friend. What's in your heart tonight?

Thank you so much for obeying God and stepping up to do these calls and stepping up to hold the line and to encourage the people who are praying, encourage the intercessors, to encourage the Ekklesia and pull us together to make these decrees and prayers together. And it's just been so powerful. And I'm also so excited to see the number. I mean, I think only God knows the number of prayer groups there are out there that are agreeing and prayer and filling the bowls of intercession, filling the bowls and sending up the incense and it's exciting to see what God is doing. And the other thing that is really on my heart is for decades and decades We have been praying for the coming, the overturning of Roe v. Wade, and now we are in a season where there's such a great possibility and we're believing God for it to be. What A season to get to be living in. We've had our flag at half mast for, I don't remember how many years it is since we received a word to "keep your flag at half mast until Roe v. Wade is overturned." So we're looking forward to putting our flag at full staff again because we're in that season and one of the things that our little prayer group has been praying--And just this evening we have we had a wonderful time praying about this that's coming up on December 1st. And it was brought to our remembrance that --and this is another thing to be thankful for; that God is moving so tremendously in the Middle East, with Jesus appearing to groups of people, to individuals. But there's also this issue of, well, let me just bring it from job 33 verse's 15 and 16 in a dream. In a Vision of the night when deep sleep falls upon men and slumberings upon the bed. Then he opens the ears of men, or he reveals or he uncovers and seals their instruction. And we've been hearing these wonderful testimonies of how entire villages-- the people have the same dream in the same night. And then somebody appears the next day to bring them the good news. Or you know that the dream indicates that somebody is coming the next day. Or here's one, where a pastor that has just started a new work was murdered in cold blood. Three men came to his door. They shot him and killed him. And god called someone else to step up and move into that same apartment and begin to take up that man's mantle and preach the gospel among these Muslims. Well, before long, three men came to his door and he thought, Okay, it's my turn. And they kidnaped him. They covered up his head. They kidnaped him. Threw him in the the back of the car, the trunk of the car. Drove and drove and drove and drove and drove. Finally, they take him out of the car, take him up some steps and into a room. Take the hood off of him and they say, we're sorry. We didn't mean to scare you. Do you know the man who was in the apartment before you? He said yes. And the men said, We're the three men who killed him. And you see these nine hundred men in this room? All of us, the same night had a dream that we had blood on our hands, but God in his mercy was going to send someone to tell us how to get the blood off of our hands. Are you that man? And of course, he said yes, and he preached the gospel to them. And all nine hundred got saved and their families. So God is moving in that way, but I want to circle back around to talk about this, this wonderful thing that God is about to do in Washington, D.C., as thousands and thousands of people are coming to pray or demonstrate or whatever they're going to do. I'm asking God, we're asking God for dreams to be given, especially to the justices of the Supreme Court, that they will all have the

same vision and the same dream in the same night. That they will have this, this kind of experience that we know God is doing in the Earth today. So we add that to our Thanksgiving. We thank you for what you're doing in the nations of the world and in this nation, and that you are turning things over and that you're going to speak to people in their dreams and bring them understanding and open their ears and open their eyes and seal instruction in their hearts that they will begin to do the right thing and to follow you and to bring repentance Lord in the name of Jesus Christ. We thank you, Father, that you're going to so pour out your spirit in this nation that even though Roe v. Wade is overturned, that abortion is going to also end because people's minds and hearts are going to be changed. That they're going to see that this is wrong. that they're going to see that it's wrong to get into a position where you need to have an abortion. That you're going to so change the morality of this nation because you're pouring out your spirit in the name of Jesus Christ. We say, thank you. Thank you. Thank you for doing all these things that you're saving America. Amen.

And then the next night, on December the 2nd, we kick off The Suddenly Convocation; the an annual regional NEI network Ekklesia International Conference. It will be streamed. David Hertel [00:28:05] Well, just thinking tonight and didn't have time to really pull up as many as there are. But thinking of being thankful for the times, the truth has come out victorious here in situations. We know that it has taken a beating over the last years. There's a scripture and I didn't look it up. But it says truth has fallen in the streets. And so when it wins, Very thankful, it's a testimony. John 8:32, very familiar scripture says: and you shall know the truth and the truth shall make you free. well thank goodness the truth is starting to release some freedom. One case that stands out to me is four and a half years ago, the case was called the state of New York versus a group pro-life advocates. And they were sued for peacefully praying and ministering outside of an abortion clinic in New York City. And after four and a half long years, those faithful pro-lifers finally got the victory. Justice ultimately prevailed for the pastor and his church at the Rock. And every defendant was fully exonerated, and it's notable that during this time, they were going through this they never stopped going to the clinic to save babies and never stopped offering help to desperate women. But they stood for truth and truth, finally gained the victory. and it sends a message that the pro-life movement is not backing down. We have truth on our side, and we will fight against the culture of death until the battle has been

completely won and truth has its way and the weakest and the most vulnerable among us without abortion will be set free also. So, we thank the Lord for that. And then the 40 days of Life organization, one that I sow into, was just giving some statistics. they said 20000 babies have been rescued since 2007, when they started, 114 clinics closed. And this was an interesting number 222 abortion clinic workers resigned. And so I thought that was an interesting number. it Stood out to me. We thank the Lord for truth prevailing there. And I praise the Lord for the verdict in the Rittenhouse trial that honored truth and helped preserve the right of self-defense measures for all of us. So, thank the Lord for truth winning there. And then the victory of truth in the courts concerning the vaccine mandates, just, they looked at it and they said, "Wait a minute, this isn't adding up and we're going to nullify these. These are not allowed." And of course, there's a president still pushing for corporations to do it. And we just bind that in Jesus name. But, we're looking for the truth to prevail in the Mississippi abortion case that's coming before the U.S. Supreme Court on December 1st. And ultimately, it will result in Roe versus Wade will be over. It'll have to go. It won't be. The legalization of the genocide of the unborn will cease in Jesus name. So I'm just thanking the Lord every time I see truth prevail and everytime I see it gain a victory. I want to celebrate that, and I know we all celebrate that so that we can see it just increase across this land. If we just had the truth manifested and then valued and supported and preserved, we would solve 99.9% of our problems I think so. So, just praising the Lord for those cases, and you can probably think of a a few more, but I thank the Lord tonight for the victory of truth emerging in this land in Jesus name. Amen.

The truth of --God's word says the truth will make us free, but also it most of the time makes us miserable first. And I believe there's-- I'm meeting a lot of people...well, That's not a totally true. I'm meeting people who are very miserable right now, and I'm hearing from people that have been on the other side. But this truth is waking them up, and it's a tremendous time that we're in. You know, I'm thankful and I'm fixing to read something here, but they just came out with a life list 2022 of the states that stood the stronges for the human right to life. it's not just about --you know, we're not just not against abortion, we're for life. And I'm going to take just a moment before Jacquie comes on. And Arkansas, praise God, that's where I live now was number one. Louisiana, two. Arizona, Three. Oklahoma, four. Indiana, five. Mississippi, six. Kansas, seven. Idaho, eight. South Dakota was nine, Missouri was 10, Alabama 11, Texas 12, Kentucky 13, Tennessee 14. North Dakota 15, Georgia 16, Utah 17, Michigan 18, Ohio 19, Nebraska 20, south Carolina 21, florida 22. Pennsylvania 23. Wisconsin 24, Iowa 25. West Virginia 26. Wyoming 27. North Carolina 28. Minnesota 29. Delaware 30. Virginia 31. Montana 32. Alaska 33. New Hampshire 34. Colorado 35. Nevada 36. Illinois 37. Maine 38. Maryland 39. Rhode Island 40. Connecticut 41, California 42, Massachusetts 43, New York 44, Washington State 45 and Hawaii 46. New Mexico 47, Oregon 48, New Jersey 49. And Vermont 50. And so, if you're on here tonight from Vermont, you know, we all need to improve our state, but there needs to be some prayer in that. But this human right to life it begins in the womb and we are now seeing, especially in this Mississippi case, this turnaround. Jacquie, what do you have to be thankful for? I know its many things. you're getting closer to getting in your new building, but what's in your heart tonight?

From Ephesians 5, verse 20 and 21 out of the passion translation. This just really hit me today. Says: Always give thanks to Father God for every person he brings into your life in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ. And out of your reverence for Christ, be supportive of each other in love. And so I just want to start with saying I am really, really grateful for every person God's brought into my life that's on this call, us, with the host, with you, Clay, as you and Susan are such dear friends. But all of the host, but also all of the participants, like you mentioned earlier, the emails and messages that we get expressing appreciation for what we do with these calls. I just want to say thank you. Thank you. Thank you, God, for each and every one of the people that get on this call and are taking the time to send us such heartfelt messages. The pressure has caused a gratitude to come forth out of people and an appreciation of one another that I see it as such a gift from the father. It is a fruit of a difficult season. The other thing I'm very grateful for is that I believe we're moving into a new season where we're not wasting our sorrows. There was a book written by Bill Hemmer decades ago and it was entitled Don't Waste Your Sorrows, and I came upon the book today, as Clay mentioned with the new building we're about to move into. We're having to pack. Oh, that's not fun. But I'm grateful because I'm cleaning out bookshelves and that book came into my hand, and I believe we're learning to not waste our sorrows. We're not denying the sorrows, we're not denying the troubles. We're not denying the difficulties that we individually or as families, regions and a nation are walking through. But I see a growth and a maturity in us that we're not wasting the sorrows. We're allowing God to use the difficulties to produce in us a greater measure of righteousness, a greater measure of authority. And so then I want to share that I'm very grateful for the increase of maturity and authority that is coming forth out of the Ekklesia. That is answers for many people, prayers that have been prayed for many years, many years, even before us, obviously. But just that the maturity that I see, I'm very grateful for that, but I'm also very grateful for the exposure of the hidden works of darkness. I believe that when we came into this this year and the last couple of years, there were things we saw, but we didn't see as clearly as we see today. And so I'm grateful that even though it has been difficult, we're seeing things we never wanted to see. Who would have ever dreamed several years ago that we would have heard all of the atrocities that we now have out of Planned Parenthood? But I'm grateful That we see it. I'm grateful that it got brought out into the light. I'm grateful for even the exposure of the governmental overreach because it's been happening a long time. We just didn't see it. But now we're seeing it in a new way. And one thing that we know that when we can see something, we can begin to deal with it in the spirit with an authenticity that will lose

And it at times is very overwhelming. But I am very, very, very grateful. God is faithful and He is faithful, if we will follow him, he will bring us into our due season and I just want to release that over everyone on this call. Father, I thank you for your favor. I thank you for your mercy. I thank you, father, that you are walking with us through deep and dark times. But all along the way you are revealing greater and greater measures of your grace and glory. And father, I thank you for the saints of God that are rising up. That the remnant that is getting shaken but getting strengthened as we are shaken, we are coming into a greater and greater strength. And I am grateful that I'm alive at such a time as this because we are on the precipice of seeing the greatest manifestation of your glory that we beyond anything that we could ask, think or imagine. And I am thankful, father, that you are allowing us to partner with you for your kingdom purposes on earth, in these United States of America, even as it is in heaven in Jesus name. Amen.

Brother Jim Hodges, I asked you to close us out tonight with what's in your heart. We are so blessed when you're able to join us. I call you our senior statesmen. And we just appreciate the years of experience you have and how it's honed out of wisdom from you that is so needed in the-- not in the body of Christ, but especially among the Ekklesia. What do you have in your heart, sir?

And just a few reminders on the whole issue of Thanksgiving, because it's already been well said, what we're grateful for. But I want to begin with a journey that all of us on Walk with the Lord and moving toward his purposes, working in our lives to change the Earth and advance his kingdom. But I remember as a Baptist pastor hungry for the Lord and seeking the Lord. And by the way, Jacquie, I came across some of Bill Homer's books "destined for the throne", dont waste your sorrows, Watchmen. nee you don't have to have a whole journey, but the thing that probably in a wonderful way startled me, The Lord began to lead me to some people or people to me as a senior in a baptist seminary, my best friend, {inaudible} who's now with the Lord. He was a student and a pastor. And he witnessed to me about Holy Spirit baptism. at the time, I didn't respond very favorably. I was not disrespectful. But,all of a sudden I got around people like Ernie and a few other people, and I was startled. This is so simple, it's almost embarrassing to say, but I was startled by people who out of their mouth on purpose

verbally would say often Thank you, Jesus. And you know, I had to search my heart. I believe I thankful for what the Lord had done for me in saving me and put me in a good church to soften me to some measure. But to express the Thanksgiving, I think, is pretty important, right? Not just in our hearts, thankful, but to express that. So that simple statement by these, shall we say, spirit baptized folks that I wasn't used to being around to say thank you. Jesus was kind of an amazing awakening for me. Now you guys know your Bible. The word thanksgiving is rooted in the words for grace Carvis and even the Eucharist; Eucharisto. So so Thanksgiving is not just an attitude, it's a force. In fact, it's such a force that the reverse of thanks, namely not being painful, is what Paul warned us about in Romans one. It says even though they knew God, they did not honor him as God or give thanks. And you read on down in the passage, what happens in gratitude opened the door to idolatry. So it appears that ingratitude is is a downward force. And here's where we have the famous scripture. Paul talks about worshiping the creature rather than the creator or the worship of man. So think about that. So, so thanks is more than emotional feeling or a powerful expression. It's actually a force, because grace is force, you know, grace is favor. You all know that, of course, but grace is enablement. And then you just go on through there. And Paul says in one Corinthians 15:7: Thanks be to God for his indescribable gift. Obviously Our Thanksgiving always focuses upon the Lord Jesus Christ and who he is, what he's done, what he's doing, and how he is moving forward in his purposes. And then you come into the book, I'll Skip Ephesians, Jacquie covered that well, but in Philippians, you know, I think it's around 4-6 there, paul just goes and says, be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication with Thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God. Thanksgiving is not an appendage there, it's a force, come on, that is coupled with prayer and supplication and making our request known until the Lord. And then in Collosians, just next door, I'll wrap up with this before I make a few applications. Collossians 2: 6 and 7: Therefore, as you receive Christ, Jesus the Lord, so walk in him. Having been firmly rooted and now being built up in him and established in your faith, just as you were instructed and overflowing with gratitude. So I just want to say just reminders, how the word of God with the focus of our gratitude goes. Now, I'm grateful, on a practical level for the unraveling of the untrue. I'm seeing in our culture society, especially media, the unraveling of that which we, as the Ekklesia knows, happens to be lies, falsehood, delusion , lawlessness. Its Unraveling before our eyes. I'm grateful for the dismantling of the destroyers. Those who are destroying life in the womb. Come on. Just life in general. Those who are anti-life. Their agenda is being dismantled and some of them are being removed. I'm grateful for-- this have been said, but I will say it again because it's in my spirit --for the maturing and unifying of the Ekklesia. when Jesus spoke that word in Matthew 16 there, in Caesarea Philipi--think about it. I'm not sure who brought this up the other day. Maybe if I quote Dutch Sheets you'll forgive me, right? Because I don't miss GiveHim15. But since Jesus, uttered those words at Caesarea Phillipi about I'll build my church, which is Ekklesia. I'll build my government, my kingdom, the government, we're right now in a time in history when there's never been such an intense, widespread, in-depth understanding of what Ekklesia. It's not a cliché, it's not a buzz word. It is the essence of what Jesus said he would build and that which he builds as a kingdom government overcomes the gates of hell as we well know. And so I'm very grateful and i'll close with this. {Inaudible} Clay's powerful word at the Hub and the week before Apostle Tim Sheets talked about the Ekklesia hubs around the globe and

something went off in me because I'm seeing more connectivity, more understanding, more pursuit after the mission, the Lord has called us all to. And to think about how the river of God, Come on, flowing from the throne connects these Ekklesia hubs. And that's exciting. We're up to something.

May he protect your body, soul, mind and spirit, your loved ones and all your possessions. May Yahweh illuminate the wholeness of His being towards you continually bringing order so that you will fulfill your God given destiny and purpose. May Yahweh provide you with perfect love and fellowship, never leaving you and give you substance, provision, Friendship. May Yahweh lift up and carry His wholeness of being towards you, bring everything that he is to your age, supporting you with your entire being.
