### Topic: The Power of Agreement & Synergy of the Ages

**Clay Nash** [00:00:42] Well, good evening. It is now 9:00 p.m. Eastern Time, and we're on the call tonight. I appreciate, as always, the faithfulness of those that join these calls. I appreciate the hosts that balance their time and make room for the responsibility of joining the call. We're going to be talking tonight about the power of agreement and the synergy of the ages. And we will be doing some teaching expounding of the word sharing from experiences. And we just hope it will help everyone that's on the call tonight, of course, is always the call will be recorded posted to my website; claynash.org. And tonight's call, because we're teaching, will be transcribed. So we will have it up as quick as we can. Father, I thank you for today. Thank you that today is a significant day because you are a significant God, I thank you, Father, that you said where two or three gathered together in your character, authority and nature, you're there. So we thank you tonight. You're on this call. You're part of this call. You're leading us and directing us and giving us wisdom of words to share, insight, teaching and also spiritual understanding. Father, we bless every one of the host with revelation and spiritual understanding. And we just declare over everyone on the call that we have eyes to see and ears to hear and a heart hungry for God to receive and apply and move forth as Your Ekklesia. So, Father, we just bless you. We thank you that you are working in our nation. and because you are, father, we put our trust in you and we choose to believe that the victory of covenant always prevails and the kingdom is ever expanding. We thank you for these things now, in Yeshua's name, amen. Well, I'm going to open up tonight and begin to talk about the power of agreement. We will tie in also the synergy of the ages. But in the book of Matthew, Chapter 18 and verse 19, I love the scripture says "again, I say to you, if two of you agree on Earth concerning anything they ask it will be done for them by my father in heaven. But I also want to say you must balance that with psalm34:7 where it says Delight yourself in the Lord and he will give you the desires of your heart. So, Father, we just thank you tonight that as we move forward in this understanding, its going to empower and move us forward into a unity and a oneness that will cause the turnaround to come. for all the hosts on, I did fail to unmute you, but it is done now. But the message Bible speaks out of Matthew 18:15 this way. It Says when two of you get together on anything at all on earth and make a prayer of it my father in heaven goes into action. But that Psalm Scripture says, Delight yourself in the Lord, and he will give you the desires of your heart. That word delight means make pliable. Always when I teach on this one of the most pliable things that I know of as Play Doh, if you keep it in the can you keep it from drying out. And what this is saying, when you place yourself contrite and pliable in the hand of God, he's able to reach into your heart and place his desires. This is not talking about whims or fleshy or carnal desires. It is talking about the desires that he places there, because we're yielded, we're surrendered and we---even as the son of God said: not my will, but your will be done. And so tonight as we talk about the power of agreement, understand that there always is in the power of agreement, something that is released. It's unseen most of the time when it's released, but then it becomes seen. the word agreement is sumphoneo and it means to be in agreement with in unison and one accord to speak together with agreement to be harmonious, united to agree with and declare statements agreed upon to champion with the same view or vision or agree upon to regard something as settled to reach agreement. Second part of that means to be in line. Agree, accord, to stand as one to fall in to the line of footprints, to hold true, to stay in agreement with what has been spiritually attained. It's important to understand that to be in agreement is to be in unity. And when you're in unity, you're going to be speaking and champion the same vision. It is to stand. As one as we become fitly

joined together, holding true what has been agreed upon. Let me just say this. As We get in tonight to the synergy of the ages, agreement is synergy, produces synergy and synergy produces the will of God. Agreements synergy is the working together of two things to produce an effect greater than the sum of their individual parts, an advantageous agreement that results in a greater outcome. I love when my wife and I sit and we discuss things and we come into agreement. When we first got born again many, many years ago, early days of our marriage, I thought agreement was getting her to agree with me. But what I grew into maturity to understand was that true agreement is finding out what the father's saying, what the father is releasing and as we both came into agreement with him, we both came into agreement with each other. So these things are very important. I want to give you just a couple more scriptures and I will call on Dan Blacksher to share what's in his heart. But in Second Timothy, chapter three and verse sixteen, it says that all scripture is given by inspiration of God. And it is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction and righteousness. Then if we would jump over to second Peter chapter 1 and verse 21 it says for prophesy never came by the will of man, but holy man of God spoke as they were moved on by Holy Spirit. And the last one I want to give --cause True Agreement is agreeing with what God's word has said, is saying. Agreement has to line up with the word of God. But in Isaiah 40 and verse 8 it says "The grass withers, the flower fades. But the word of our God stands forever. Let me just share with you if you're on this call what God has said. He's still saying. didn't say that will live out every word that proceeded from the mouth of God. It's actually "we live not by bread alone, but by every word that is proceeding. It is a present perfect, tense word there. And what God said 5000 years ago, he is still saying. he's still blowing the breath of his authority. The breath of his righteousness upon that word. So agreement and the power of agreement. we can come in agreement right now to pray for someone in Siberia and they can experience it. I want to share this short testimony and hand it over to Dan. But we had a lady visit our healing rooms here. She needed a touch from God, but she had a friend that had just been diagnosed with Crohns disease. She was prayed for her physical healing. Then she asked the prayer team, the healing team, to pray for her friend, who was in New York City. After the prayer was over. She stepped outside of the healing room outside of the building, and she called her friend. When her friend answered, her friend said, "Oh, my God, I can't believe you called now. said I'm in a dressing room trying on a dress and God just came up on me. Well, end of the story, not only did that prayer produce a manifestation that the woman experienced in New York--a long way from Memphis, Tennessee, it also produced a healing. went back, all signs, all inflammation, everything. No sign of it, no Crohn's disease. God is a great God. Dan, what do you have in your heart?

**Dan Blacksher** [00:10:19] Thank you so much, brother. This morning, as I got your e-mail and I was meditating and we were in worship and prayer over synergy of the ages and the power of agreement, immediately, the Lord took me to Genesis Chapter 28. And what the Lord began to do was he began to show me and revealed to me how God used the appeal to heaven movement for something that was bigger than just praying for our nation. And let me explain it. Yes, it was about praying for our nation and all of those things that we did leading up to this last election. But the Lord said to me, and he had me call Dutch and share it with him, is that he was using those appeal to Heaven times as an encounter with God, as a vessel like what happened to Jacob, where now all of a sudden in the present, a person gets connected to something that God promised, covenanted and started in a previous generation. And if you remember back on all of those conferences, the worship was so amazing, angelic encounters, people were seeing angels dispatched and released. And also what was happening was, is that God was taking the intercessors and helping them understand that they were connected to something far bigger that started in a previous generation and started by God covenanting something with that previous

generation. And I felt like the Lord begin to show me that that was positioning us for when you come to Jacob's next encounter with God, he's wrestling with God. And I felt as if the Lord said the last election, we began this wrestling with God. We're wrestling with him for a nation. Not that he doesn't want to give it to us, but we're actually wrestling for the blessing of our new name as the Ekklesia. And so what the Lord said to me was he said, I've used that as one of the things that's completely giving the intersession movement a new name. And the Lord began to reveal to me. He kept bringing the remembrance. And I shared this on the afternoon prayer call. I had a friend in Baton Rouge when I lived there in the 90s, early 90s. He was a structural engineer and he would do calculations on his off time like we would do a crossword puzzle or something. And there's a bridge that goes over the Mississippi River in Baton Rouge. And he had calculated the exact spot on that bridge where he could walk out there with a hammer, hit that bridge one time a day. He calculated that it would take him like twenty-five years and 50 days of doing that once every day. And he said and on that twenty fifth year, on that fiftieth day, that entire structure would fall into the Mississippi River. And it really, as I was meditating on that and meditating on how God used the appeal to heaven and everything you're doing, Clay, and what Dr. Miller's doing and all the people that are host on this call, I saw that hammer and it had the word Ekklesia on it. And a hammer in a dream represents justice. I felt like the Lord said we've come to that place where we have the authority to hit those demonic structures in such a way where it is actually going to cause them to fall in the spirit. In other words, when it fell into the river, you know, it was still a bridge. It just happened to be underwater. In other words, you had to go through the water to get to your destination. I felt the Lord say, I'm raising up-- that we're literally on the dawn of God, releasing a new name to us as the body of Christ with a new authority. That's what everybody seen with the glory being released, the healings, the miracles, the signs and the wonders. And even today on the prayer call, Pat brought up that he was in the military when they would march across a bridge--This is the power of agreement -- when they would march across a bridge, their instructor, their drill instructor would tell them to march out of time. The reason he would tell them to march out of time is that synchronized of the heel coming down on the bridge, they said with that many soldiers walking at the same time, the reverberation of that could cause damage to the structure that was holding that bridge up. So I just want to encourage everybody. This is the dawning, I believe, of a new day. I believe we're on the verge of God releasing that blessing of a new name to the body of Christ. It releases a new provision that releases a new authority. It releases a new purpose. In other words, Jacob didn't realize that his destiny would be fulfilled only...and the name that God had reserved for him would only be released when he rightly connected to what he was supposed to pick up and carry, and that was a covenant and a promise to a previous generation. I believe that's what we did. I believe that's what we're doing. I believe that's why what Robert Hunt did and all the founding fathers, all of the Peter Muilenburg (sp?), all of the ones that we have honored, God is connecting us to the covenant that he made with them, the promise that he gave with him. And he's positioning us to bless us with a new name. And don't think that people haven't got out of joint. Hips have got out of joint. There are people that have got out of joint with the prophetic and prophets. There are people that have gotten out of joint but it will not stop the new name from being released and the promise being fulfilled and the covenant carried further down the line, as Jacob did, even though he did it with a limp, he still did it. And so I just want to bless everybody. I feel like the Lord saying we're on the eve of a new name and it is connected to the synergy of the ages.

**Clay Nash** [00:16:20] Amen Dan. Great stuff. Hey, if you can get in touch with that guy in Baton Rouge, ask him, is he been hitting this bridge in Memphis with that hammer? We've got a bridge closed off crossing the Mississippi River and it's got a crack. And I just wonder

if he is the guy behind it. Because, let me just tell you, I go back to Arkansas, so it's become a challenge. I'm having to leave a couple hours early to get over in the state at times with that. But that's excellent. Excellent. It's so true about that, that walking is one. And that's what the soldiers do. And they walk in that cadence. When they walk in that rhythm, their walking as one and it will put that kind of pressure on it. All right, Regina Shank, what do you have to contribute tonight?

**Regina Shank** [00:17:10] Well, thank you. Excuse me for my voice. I have a little laryngitis, but I was looking at synergy. I think it's a powerful concept and it is interaction or cooperation of two or more organizations or substances or agents to produce a combined effect greater than the sum of their separate parts. And that is us as we agree with the prayers of those who've already gone on to the cloud of witnesses. And my mother passed away in 2003. She was a prayer warrior. I have picked up some of her manuals, some of her notes, and set myself in agreement with what she prayed several years ago for the family, for the future. And I believe that we can do that with those who have gone before us. And that agreement is there. And one of the things the Lord showed me, and I'm sure everybody is aware of this, but I just want to remind us today of what it says in first, Peter 1, I think it's verse 23 here: for you have been born again, not a perishable seed, but of imperishable through the living and enduring word of God. And I begin to think about the imperishable seed of our prayers, how those prayers have gone out into the atmosphere, into the heavenlies, and they are still there. The seeds that my mother sowed when she was alive praying for our family, they don't, they're not corruptible. They're incorruptible. In other words, they're still there. And so I can agree with what she prayed years ago. And my prayers with her prayers produce a synergy that produces results. And I think if we see our prayers as we're just throwing them out there, well, it didn't happen, you know, but that seed is incorruptible and it is still coming forth. And so we agree with that. And then I was looking at Hebrews 11, which is so key, and it does talk to us about the prayers that others prayed. And it says, "these were commended for their faith, yet none of them received what had been promised. God had planned something better for us so that only together with us would they be perfect." And that's that synergy that we're talking about. You know, and I know Dan mentioned a Reverend Robert Hunt. We've been agreeing with his prayers, his decree's for several years now, and that is synergy. And we're continuing to do so. And when we look at Abraham and his life, he was called a father of nations. wait a minute. He had two sons. He had Isaac born by the spirit, had Ishmael born of his flesh. He's a father of nations. That's two kids. Well, when you go on further then there's Jacob, who had 12 sons. And so Abraham is the father of nations, but it didn't happen until two generations later. I don't want that to seem like, oh, we're not going to get it for two generations. I don't believe that's what the Lord saying. But I do believe that when we pray together with the previous prayers of our ancestors and we decree together like you and I Clay, if we were to agree for something, there's power in that. There's synergy in our prayers and in our agreement for those that we're praying for. And that's why it's important for us not only to pray individually, but to come together with the body of Christ and begin to to decree things that will come forth. And it's like two oxen pulling a load. individually, they can't pull much. And the sum of their two abilities is not the same as when they pull together. And so the Lord wants us to move together in our prayers and in our agreement so that we can see more power released among us because we're in agreement. And I love that concept. And so I just want to say that all the prayers that we have prayed on these calls, all the things that we have decreed that is incorruptible seed that is still there, it is going to bring forth a crop. I remember when my grandmother put seeds in the ground, she saw a crop. We have put seeds in the ground of prayers and we are going to see those seeds spring forth and bring this nation into its purpose. And also, as we pray for our families, those same things. And I remember doing a family prayer proclamation and

putting it on the refrigerator at my house because I go refrigerator often and I would decree it every time I saw that. And that was incorruptible seed being released into the atmosphere. And God is hearing that. And also when someone agreed with me, it gave it more synergy. So I just want to speak the synergy of the ages, the importance of agreement. That's why the enemy likes to divide and conquer. But we are together in this and we're going to see the results of our prayers. And I love what Dan said and what Pat said about the army marching together. Hey, we are marching together and we're going to see some breakthrough in this nation.

**Clay Nash** [00:22:48] Amen. Thank you, Regina. That's for sure. You know, several years ago, I heard Dr. Don Lynch do some teaching on new weapons for a new era. But just to add in to what Dan said while ago, I heard recently in my prayer closet, the Lord say that I've got some fresh weapons for this new era. And so I've been asking Him to reveal those weapons. And but I do know that they will step back into the power of agreement, but also look at all the prayers of the patriarchs that are in God's word that we go back and we agree and we quote and we decree and we declare and we war with those words. And they're so important. You know, I love going back through some of the prayers. You know, when I found them, some of George Washington's writings there at Valley Forge when he said, unless we make our appeal to heaven right, we stand no chance of winning this war. And we know that he commissioned what was known as the Washington Kreuzer flag, which we call, is known as the Appeal to Heaven flag today. So there's so much that we can tie in those prayers... God led prayers don't die. And as already been said here, prayers that our grandmothers and grandfathers and uncles and aunts and friends and that have prayed over the years over families and dedications and words that were spoken, they're still alive and they're still there for us to connect through the power of agreement and see the synergy of the ages prevail, Sharon Buss, you're with us tonight....

**Regina Shank** [00:24:40] Hey Clay?

**Clay Nash** [00:24:40] Yes? Go ahead.

**Regina Shank** [00:24:41] I'm sorry. Can I say one more thing?

**Clay Nash** [00:24:43] Sure.

**Regina Shank** [00:24:43] You know, my sister and I, we were like four and five years old when my grandfather passed away. And I heard this story that he took my sister and I outside and he prayed over us. He released over us God's blessing. And I don't remember what he said, but I remember the instance. And then I just got a call from my uncle, my mother's youngest brother, who is my grandfather's son, of course. And he is moving in his calling in the church that he's a part of and he's a leader there. And I began to see the synergy of our inheritances from our grandfather, our uncle, my mother, myself. Those prayers are, some of them, now, just now being fulfilled of what was spoken a couple of generations ago. And so I know God is going to fulfill those in our bloodlines as well. So I just wanted to say that. I meant to say that earlier.

**Clay Nash** [00:25:48] All right. Thank you, Regina, for that. Sharon Bush, what's in your heart?

**Sharon Buss** [00:25:54] Hi, Clay. Thank you so much for pulling this thing together tonight. This is a wonderful, wonderful subject. And I love just meditating on it and getting further revelation because that's what happens as each generation comes along. Each

generation gets a little bit more and gets a little bit more. And we're building on the foundation that Jesus laid himself through the apostles and the prophets. And and we're building on that. And every generation has more revelation. We get a revelation. And, you know, our parents got a revelation. Our grandparents got a revelation. But our parents revelation built on the revelation they learned from their parents. And we're building on the next revelation as it comes to us. And each generation adds revelation. So it's adding more and more light. It's adding more and more strength as we walk together. What I'm seeing in the spirit. I had a vision some years ago of the wedding of the lamb. You know, Jesus is standing at the front of the I guess you could say church wherever a wedding is taking place. You know, the groom is standing there waiting for the bride to walk down the aisle. And what I saw was each individual that is a part of the bride, each and every one had the chance individually to walk down the aisle and meet him. But as each person got there, they merged into the bride. So there's one bride at the end of the aisle. But each one of us are walking into that one bride. And as we individually walk with God, every one of us receiving revelation from the Holy Spirit, we are experiencing something that's unique in our walk with him. Everybody sees something a little bit differently. Everybody hears something a little bit differently. And we begin to add our agreement with each other by our agreement with him. And I think you kind of made that point at the beginning of this. But it's as we walk with him, it's as we relate to our father. You know, he obviously gave us the rules in order that we... I should say, in an order. And the first one being love the Lord, your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your mind, with all your strength. And then you love your neighbor as yourself. And as we and our neighbor are walking with God individually, we are creating an atmosphere and each of us individually has an atmosphere around us. Have you ever seen how to bubbles... You know you're blowing bubbles with the kids right? Outside or wherever, you know, and you get two bubbles and you get them next to each other and they merge together and it makes a bigger bubble than either of the bubbles was. And it's the same. It's another illustration of synergy. It's another illustration of what God is doing with us. And I'm looking at Romans 12 and verses 4 & 5, it says, I'm looking in the passion: "In the human body there are many parts and organs, each with a unique function. And so it is in the body of Christ, for though we are many. We've all been mingled into one body in Christ. This means that we are all vitally joined to one another with each other, contributing to the others". And as long as we keep getting it right in our walk with our father, he's going to give us the grace to get it right with walking with each other. And that's where the synergy comes in. When we're in agreement with him, it's so much easier to be in agreement with each other. And the other thing that came to me when I was meditating about this is the vision that Tommy Hicks had in nineteen sixty one of this huge, huge giant that was stretched across the whole earth. his head was in the South Pole and his feet were in the North Pole and his arms went from ocean to ocean and he was covered up with debris and just it was a mess. And he could see these little creepy demonic creatures. And they were keeping this this giant held down. There was some kind of restraint there. And every time that the giant would try to move and there'd be some kind of a quivering going on, then the demons would run. But as soon as it got stilled and then the demons would come back and keep doing their thing. But then there came a moment when this when this thing came to life and it stood up and had one foot on the land and one foot on the sea and was there was a mighty outpouring that came. And then then he saw the giant melt into the whole earth and then he saw individuals coming together as the body of Christ. So the giant is the body of Christ that's being that's you know, there's been an attack against the body of Christ all the ages that ever have been since Adam. And, you know, there's just been this struggle in the spirit. And I see that there is this...umm... It's time, it's just time. We are in that time, I believe we're in that time. And I'm also reminded of the word that Chuck Pierce released just very recently. And it was this is part of it at least. It says, "Watch Israel. Watch May 26th. watch

the atmosphere shift..." And then, I don't remember exactly the wording, but it's something like according to your choices or I think it's something like that. And that's where when we have our hearts turned, toward our father. His will knits with our will as our spirit and his spirit are knit together, are joined together and merged together so that we can merge that glory that comes out of us as we gather together, as we honor the Jesus in each other's, as we honor the Holy Spirit in each other. It multiplies and it multiplies. And it's not just in as we've been saying, it's not just in the here and now. It is building on previous generations so that what is coming now is far more glorious than we have seen in the past. And as the Lord spoke to me, what we're about to see in this coming harvest is the final harvest that the Book of Acts was the seed form of. It was the first fruits version of the big thing that's coming right now. And it's going to be like the book of Acts on steroids. But we're building on all of these things that have been coming together and coming together and coming together. And our job is to serve our generation well, as David did. And I believe for something really amazing, really amazing. And, you know, it could happen tomorrow. Watch May 26th. Amen.

**Clay Nash** [00:34:07] Amen. Thank you, Sharon for that. Pat, you're with us tonight. What can you add to all of this?

**Pat McManus** [00:34:17] {chuckling} It's really been pretty good. There's a whole lot that's been said. So thank you Clay for the opportunity to really come in agreement and alignment with what's going on. And one of the things that Sharon kind of was tapping into it and laying the foundation on it. And the one thing that the Lord is really showing me is the oneness that God is calling us to be in one. So and John, chapter 17, starts at verse 21... 20, actually--"I do not pray for these alone, but also for those who believe in me through their word that they may be one as you father are in me and I and you, that they may be one in us, that the world may believe that you sent me and the glory which you have given me, I've given to them that they may be one just as we are one". And the reality of the synergy of the ages is coming back to that foundational expression of being one with the father in every dimension of life and every way of life, no matter how, no matter where, no matter what. So I really believe that God is beginning to bring us into a place of foundational understanding to reflect the very nature of his word, his will and his way. And I as I was thinking about this this morning and being one and understanding being one, which is unlocking the synergy, I read this in Proverbs, chapter one, verse four. And it's really just triggered some things for me. And it says this: These proverbs will be given you great skill to teach the immature and make them wise to give youth the understanding of their designed destiny. When we truly in and impact and challenge culture to come into being one with the father, we're unlocking a designed destiny, but reveals our identity to be able to be effective into the purpose of what God is releasing. So the oneness reflects that impartation or the individual impartation where God is releasing within us, where we can be fathers to the next generation, to linking together as like a... they always put, when they're plowing... Clay, you probably know more about this than I do. But when my uncles, they told me about when they would put animals together, they would put a mature one together with the one that was immature and they would pull the wagons and being able to do things together. And I think when we begin to start looking at the synergy of the ages, we're not just embracing the decrees that were established from what Robert Hunt and others did for our nation. What was unlocking in them to come and actually do that is we're connecting all the way back to what Jesus said, father, make them one. And when that oneness comes the revelation of his power, his grace, his wisdom as understanding will be effective in the hearts of what God is doing within us. And when we do that, we begin to realize the identity of who we are in him. I was with a businessman one day and this businessman told me, he said, I know what part of the body I am. And I

looked at him and here's a corporate executive, a major businessman. He owns a Fortune 500 company, just tremendous in his skill set in the corporate world. But he said to me, said, Pat, I know who I am and the body of Christ. He said, I'm the cell in the knee. Each part is significant to be able to build a body to come into its true, true sense of identity, purpose and destiny. So we need the synergy of the ages, empowering, imparting, activating and stirring. There's always mentors to help us to be able to fulfill the purpose. I've had many people, many fathers, different people that were mentors in my life. And the same thing applies as we move forward. The empowering, bringing us to a place, as Dan mentioned, being one to be able to be effective, to be able to be productive, but also to bring an impact and change the culture. So the synergy for me is coming into that place to be in one. Like Lance Wallnau says, "as one." When we get that, we have a voice, we have a purpose, we have a power. And I believe we have a force to be reckoned with as we move forward in the plan that God is releasing in and through us to bring change in the environment and the culture that God has positioned us in. Brother Jim Hodges, I'm calling on you next, but I want to tell you a prayer that Abraham Lincoln prayed that I stepped back in to the synergy of the ages. And I pray this prayer and I come in agreement with it often. But he prayed, "almighty God, who has given us this good land for our heritage. We humbly beseech thee that we may always prove ourselves, a people mindful of thy favor and glad to do thy will. Bless our land with honorable ministry, sound learning, and pure manners. That's a very strong prayer to me. I love stepping back in to some of George Washington's prayers, Abraham Lincoln, other great leaders. John Wesley has got tremendous prayers. I'm reading his complete diary right now. I'm reading his diary right now and there's just so many prayers that just so not only energize me, but there is a synergy of the ages on them and they're just so significant for the time we're in. Brother Jim Hodges, what's in your heart tonight, sir?

**Jim Hodges** [00:39:59] OK, Clay, am I on? I'm makin sure I'm off mute.

**Clay Nash** [00:40:01] yes sir you are, we hear you well.

**Jim Hodges** [00:40:03] Thank you very much. It was exciting a couple of days ago to get the title for our topic tonight, Synergy of The Ages and the Power of Agreement. Years ago, there was a phrase I'm not sure who said it first it might have been Mar Barillo (sp?). Sounds like something he might say, but he mentioned coming into critical mass in the spirit, coming to a place where something has to be released and something has to happen. And I believe that the synergy of the ages, which is as far as I can tell, and I've been around a while, I think I'm probably the oldest guy on this call. But I think the first time I heard that talk was through Dutch, by the way, I've just learned a lot through Dutch. but the synergy of the ages, of course, assumes agreement in prayer, as we agree, not just with those we're praying with literally on a call or in person, but agreeing with those who prayed before us, as we heard some private testimonies tonight from Sharon and Regina and others about all that. So I just want to say to start off, I got stirred because I went back, like all of you do it and check on the words. So what I came up with was simply synergy yoked with symphony. And of course, Clay started us off tonight, Matthew, 18, where the word agree, as we all know, is suphono. And so it's obviously a pretty awesome word because it lends itself to hearing the many sounds of an orchestra, all the different instruments, how they're played and what sounds they release. And you put them all together. And it's a powerful, powerful release of sound. And when I thought about that, I thought about as we pursue this dynamic of synergy of the ages and the power of

agreement with those who prayed before, even maybe centuries before. But we also have got to know it's not just prayer, it's worship. It includes, if you will, sound since agreement comes from the word symphoneo. I just want to touch on that. And lately my heart has been kind of, shall we say, recaptured or in some situations captivated for the very first time hearing sounds of previous moves of God and going back some of the old Celtic hymns and not just going back to sing an old song, because I love what's coming out today in the spirit. But there was this power. when you go back to the original song that really, as it were, God used powerfully in the Welsh revival, or you can go back to different moves that some of us have lived through. And what captivated my heart early on as a pastor of a denominational church was not so much the gifts of spirit, though that was certainly an awakening for me. But what captivated my heart was the sound and the sounds of previous moves or even the sounds of worship that I was totally unfamiliar with and unaccustomed to. So I'm sensing this great symphony, not just of prayer and intercession, but of the sounds coming forth to really begin to see the breakthrough we've been hearing about today through Dan and others that's soon upon us and seems like the presence of God and the glory of God are just coming out of these sounds and you put them all together and it's, shall we say, something like heaven. And we've already had great definition, I think, especially from Regina, concerning the word synergy. It's the word Sunergos or Sunergo plural, which simply translates to fellow workers. In 1 Corinthians, 3:9 Sir Paul honors people in Romans 16 he's worked with and the gospel, right? But he calls them fellow workers in Corinthians and they have synergized the apostle himself, they're God's field, but they're God's fellow workers. And that sounds like a simple a simple definition, but it's more than just casual working together. It's realizing that if we yoke up in the Lord in Covenant and in God's purpose, we do produce. I think Regina pointed out, we produce more than double the efforts of any one of us, classically illustrated by those two horses pulling, they do far more than double the weight one could pull. So it's exponential release, isn't it? It's not just a {inaudible} release. It's exponential. It's releasing potential not yet released as we synergize with the Saints who've gone before, the prayers, their intercession, their sounds and coming into a greater, greater symphony. So one day, the symphony here totally, totally replicates the symphony in heaven. So I'm excited today. Everything we're all about and who we are as Ekklesia is just strengthened and supported by knowing we can pray the prayers of those who've gone before us be they notable, famous or just average people. But they knew how to touch heaven and touch God in prayer. So thanks for having this topic. There's a lot more to it than I'm learning just hearing you teach tonight. And so I appreciate it very, very much. Thank you.

**Clay Nash** [00:46:13] Thank you, Brother Jim, appreciate it. It's kind of been stirring in my heart before Jacquie speaks. I've been doing several years studying on the word generation, and when I'm coming to conclude and I'm going to put this out there loosely, I've not come to critical mass. And Brother Jim, let me just say this, Dale Rubble, who was connected to Kelly Bohner, actually wrote a book 100 years ago on Critical Mass. He was one of the first that I heard began to step in, but it came out of some of I can't remember. I think it Dick Iverson, I think he was Frank Damasio's father-in-law. But I read some of the stuff they had. But the first one that I found was Dale Rubble years ago. You know, they had some very exciting things moving on the East Coast there. And so a lot of people have used it. But that's the first one. In fact, somewhere probably in a box now, maybe in my library. I still have that book. Maybe I need to go back and read it. But I haven't come to a critical mass about this. But I, I will tell you that in the Hebrew language, when the word generation is used, it's speaking more of an order being connected together, which produces synergy More so than three different age group. when it speaks about Abraham, Isaac and Jacob, when I'm coming and I say this and fear and trembling with some of the

people that's on this call, I don't know if he's listening in on his own. I certainly do. But when I'm coming to understand that, it has to do with an order in Abraham, Isaac and Jacob being connected properly. And that's what produces the synergy. And so when David when it's written of David in the Book of Acts, when David served his generation, well, he slept with the Lord. It was being brought everybody alive at that time. He didn't just serve those who were his age group. And maybe this needs to be a topic for another discussion on it. But I just wanted to add that in. You got something Brother Jim?

**Jim Hodges** [00:48:43] No, go ahead. that helped. that's all. I'll look up Dale Rubble too. Thank you.

**Clay Nash** [00:48:47] All right. All right. Well, Jacquie, you're with us. What have you got tonight?

**Jacquie Tyre** [00:48:54] Oh, I am with you. And it's an honor, as always. Such great revelation coming in from everybody on the call. I could just get swallowed up. And what everybody's sharing and the piece that was stirring in my heart today, the Lord took me back to an encounter I had with him a number of years ago, maybe twenty-five to thirty years ago. And I heard the Lord say there are mantles that have been lost, discarded, tossed aside, even stolen from past generations. If you want them, you can have them. And at that point in my journey, I had not a clue what a mantle would represent, but I knew it was the Lord. And I said, Lord, whatever that is, I want it. So lead me. And what I have come to understand over the years is that those are the callings, the gifts, the authority, the anointing's that God had assigned to say my family line, and we could take this and expand it to a nation, to a territory, to a city, a state of what God had called and appointed for my family to walk in, for our nation to walk in. I believe this is what we're doing with Robert hunt. We're picking up that mantle of covenant for the United States. When we come into an agreement with what God has said, what God has assigned, it produces that synergy of the ages. As I began walking this out, I knew my family had been believers for generations, faithful and but I did not know until I was standing in front of the kitchen sink with my grandmother when she was well into her 90s. And as we look out over her kitchen sink and down the country driveway in front of her property was a little white country church. And she's standing there all four foot ten or eleven of her. And she says, you know, my granddaddy gave the property for that church. And I went, whoa, I did not know that, and it was not it was around that same time period that I was hearing the Lord speak to me about starting city gate Atlanta. And in that moment, suddenly the mantles of past generations. I knew I was picking it up. I knew I was coming into the synergy of the ages. When I went to Ireland and to Scotland, to Wales, to the Celtic nations, and began and brother Jim stirred this up in me... Began to step into those lands where my forefathers had come from and began to hear the Celtic Christian stories and hear those songs that at the feet of my other grandmother, I heard from my childhood. Suddenly I realized the synergy of the ages. The mantels of generations gone by were being stirred up inside of me. And the more I came into an agreement with those sounds, with those callings, with those anointing's, those things that when I look at my family line now, I can see various aspects of who I am, who I am becoming, who I have become and who I am becoming. And it's bringing that synergy because I simply said to the Lord, I want those things that you tell me I can have. And I stepped in to that to reclaim and move into the flow of synergy. When I think synergy along with thinking symphony, I also think of the flow, the mounting river stream that grows stronger and stronger as it comes down the mountain side. It may start as a trickle. But as it grows and it continues, it gets stronger and stronger as it continues, all rivers start as a trickle. And I believe as we come into an agreement with the synergy of the ages, with those gifting's, calling's and anointing's, mantels, if you

will, of past generations, we agree with God. Agree with him and allow God to do the work in us in our intercession, but also in our obedience, our growth our maturity, our connecting with other people that are connected to those assignments and those things that God has placed within our family lines. Then we can move into a greater fullness and the synergy doesn't stop with us. We pick it up, we keep growing. We pray in order to bring it forth and send it into the coming generations that will follow after us. And I completely follow this with Clay that we serve our generation well, all that are living. But some that are alive while we're alive will live on beyond us and carry that synergy and pass it on to those that follow. And as we do this, coming into an agreement with heaven, coming into agreement with what has been and releasing our prayers as a force of synergy into the future, I believe we'll see an incredible, incredible momentum grow so that each generation, each new round of people, if you will, doesn't have to start over. But we step into what is already moving forward. And I'll close with this. I remember one of my early mentors in intercession and in ministry, his name was Armen Geshwine (sp?). He actually led the first prayer tent for Billy Graham's very first crusade in California, and he did his prayer tents for a number of years. Powerful man of God, just an intercessor in his 90s. He could stay on his knees and pray to put the rest of us that at that time in our thirties would put us to shame because he could just stay on his knees in prayer and such shake heaven. But I remember one of the last things that he said to me was always, remember, you're simply walking in the answers to somebody else's prayers. And that has been a remembrance for me, and I believe that ties into the synergy and the agreement of the ages to see the kingdom of God advance on Earth as it is in heaven. And I believe we do this personally. We do it for our families and we do it for our regions and our nation. And it is a wonderful revelation for us to step into. So thank you Clay for the privilege of sharing and being a part of these calls. God bless you.

**Clay Nash** [00:56:31] Thank you, Jacqui, for being a part, thank all of you, David Hertel, I'm gone call on you next, but I want to just bring something in, kind of amplify something Jacqui said. You know, the Mississippi River is one of the great rivers of the world. And but it's not just a great river. The Mississippi River has two hundred and forty-some tributaries that flow into it. 40-some of them are major, like the Ohio, the Missouri. And I was also thinking of the scripture. Brother Jim called this quite often. And I appreciate every time he does, there's such an authority on it. But many are the streams that make glad the city of God. And that's actually speaking... I've done a message for years and recently got some enlightenment from Brother Jim, but God began with a garden in Genesis, but he ends up with a garden like city in Revelation. And we understand that this comes from synergy. But my last thing before I turn it over to David, you could put two hundred and sixty horse tractors in a field with a twenty-one foot disc behind each one and if those two drivers know how to work together, one tractor will get over 20-some acres in a day. Two of them can get over 60-some acres if they work together. But if they're just out there in the field not working together, they'll only double what they're doing, which is not synergy. And we are at a place, the Ekklesia that was rising has now stood to its feet. We are being fitly joined together and there is a synergy of the ages out of the prayers of yesterday, the prayers of the cloud of witnesses, the prayers of those that's gone before us. But even greater than that, we're learning we're being ketarteso (sp?), we're being aligned properly. And that's what those two drivers must do, align properly. And we're going to see even greater and greater and greater and greater synergy in the days to come. I hope that encouraged you. David Hertel, we need to hear from you.

**David Hertel** [00:58:47] Real, real quickly, I just you know, several people have already mentioned some things that-- Regina mentioned workforce's, you mentioned the tractors, Jacqui mentioned the serving our generation and the... And I just want to say, I recall the

fairgrounds when they have during the fair when they have the competition of the draft horses, one horse could pull a thousand pounds, but two--Now it just sounds like a stretch, but seems I recall that two pulled six thousand pounds, if they knew how to work together, not just two horses pulling together, but two who had the rhythm and could work in synergy, could do six times as much together. So Synergy's almost an unexplainable phenomenon. And when you add the realm of the spirit into it and you pull in the same harness as a previous generation, and not only that, but the generation coming is pulling in the same harness because of the eternal now that we can walk in, there's an unusual thing that can be released and accomplished. I just...the only other thing that I want to add, is that I've always asked my worship team leaders if someone was wanting to be on the worship team, wanting to sing, you know, wanting to be part of it. I said all I want to know from you is not just how good they are, how well they can play their instrument, but do they add to the synergy of the team because we want that to be what is added to not just someone who can who can fit and yet if it breaks down the synergy, we've actually lost something, even though we might have added another technically accurate sound. So synergy is a big deal. I think we can tap into it with honor as we honor what God's honoring, as we honor who he has honored, what he has honored. I think there's a way that we tap into that synergy. And so it's just an honor to be tapping in with y'all tonight. And we're going to see some great things out of it. So God bless you.

OK, well, Father, we thank you for tonight. We thank your father that we've been experiencing for some time the power of agreement that is producing synergy. Father, we thank you that our nation is turning. And I thank you, Father. I'm reminded now remind those on this call that it's been prophesied by Jane Hamon. It would be a year of conflict and a year of contending. And when I heard that, Lord, I heard you say, but we will contend from the victory of covenant. And when Jesus looked down and said it is finished, he was speaking out of that new and better covenant that came through his sacrifice. So, Father, we just declare from the victory of covenant and from the promises of God, we enter into the power of agreement and we thank you that out of that the synergy of the ages is winning, is prevailing, is producing. It is shifting. I think you Father that through the synergy of the ages we are going to see the rooting out, pulling down, plucking up so that we can build and plant. And out of that father, this nation, your nation, our nation, the United States of America will come in to a new identity, which is actually your original design and identity for this nation. Let it be in Yeshua's name. Baptize us Lord, forward, into that new identity and let us be recorded among the living in Jerusalem and do so in Yeshua's name. Amen and Amen.
