

Prayer Call Wednesday, April 5, 2023 – ARKANSAS

CLAY NASH: Alright, good day, everyone. Today we're going to be pressing into the state of Arkansas. And I think most of you on the call know, Arkansas is very dear to me. It's where I was born. I lived a few years away from here as I traveled and started churches, but God has brought Susan and I back to North Arkansas. And we are blessed to be here. Some storms came in through here early this morning, so I've been up since about 4:30 a.m. Prayed about the storms; prayed about some other things God burdened my heart with, but I've been so excited about today's call. Not just because it's Arkansas, but for the fact that I stepped back into a word from February 24, 2004. And it was also given a couple of other times. I think one time at Dr. Dwain Miller's church: "As Goes Arkansas, so Goes the Nation". All 50 states have significant words like that. So, we're not trying to in any way lift Arkansas up above any other state, but we know we have a part to play in the turning of this nation.

Remind you that every call is recorded, and every call is transcribed. I just talked with a publisher awhile ago and we're going to work on after this, turning all of the transcriptions into a resource so that the intercessors in every state can get hold of these words, these declarations, these decrees. I want to thank from the very depth of my heart all hosts who are so faithful about coming on this call. Some of you have been on this call since I started five years ago for Justice Kavanaugh. There was a period of time we did it seven days a week. Boy, that was taxing. But anyway, we're seeing some accomplished.

Today we're going to also remember, this is very important, coming up April the 20th through the 22nd, the Josiah Company Convocation. It's going to be about prayer for the nation. We're going to be praying for all 50 states. We're going to gather in Conway, Arkansas. That's very near Little Rock; the airport. The facility is about 10 minutes off I-40. It's a great facility, but we're going to be there the April 20th-22nd. We're going to be pressing into God, and we're going to be connecting intercessors in the states and even across state lines so that we can carry prayer by the Ecclesia to a whole other level.

I'm excited today and I'm ready to declare and decree about the great state of Arkansas. I'm going to begin by sharing several years ago, back in 2015 the Lord spoke to me to construct in Arkansas a trail of hope. We actually began this in Hope, Arkansas. We did 14 meetings in 14 locations in 12 months. We began to see a lot of things shift into a greater capacity for the state of Arkansas. One of the words that was released in West Memphis, Arkansas was released by Dutch Sheets. He prophesied that God was taking Arkansas – remember this was 8 years ago, December 2015 – God was taking Arkansas off of life support so that it could become life support to the nation. I stand here on that word today. Look at what's taking place politically in the state of Arkansas from the conservative hearts that are here in this state, those that are yielded to God, those that are surrendered to see God's will done among our children. Since Sarah Sanders has become Governor there has been an acceleration. Many great things that are taking place. We are going to pour out today by declaring and decreeing

and prophesying over this state. We're going to start with my friend up in Illinois, Pat McManus, what's in your heart?

PAT MCMANUS: Thank you, Clay. It truly is an honor to be with everyone today as we stand linking our shields together. As I was pondering Arkansas this morning, or today, and thinking about it, I just kept hearing the words: Kingdom Culture. The thought come to mind: I am this day resetting Arkansas into a clear expression of my hand. I'm resetting the very core of the land to reflect all that I am. I am releasing the wind to blow on the land and to establish my Kingdom Culture and to unlock an identity of all that I am. Set your heart on me and see what I'm about to do as I release a sound to empower you. The waves of glories are coming so step into your destiny and see my power revealed.

Hebrews 12:28 "Therefore, since we are receiving a kingdom which cannot be shaken, let us have grace by which we may serve God acceptably with reverence and godly fear." Father, I thank You that You are setting Arkansas to establish a foundational expression of what it means to walk with a Kingdom Culture, that will truly empower and impact a nation because of the alignment of the heart, and the attitudes that You're releasing within to see the fullness of Your hand prevail on our land. We thank You, Father, for it, in Jesus name. Amen and Amen.

CLAY NASH: Alright, Pat. Thank you. We come in agreement with your declarations and decrees, and that prophetic unction that you released. And, Father, we just declare Yes and Amen. We declare so be it, for the state of Arkansas. Regina Shank, there in Missouri, what's in your heart?

REGINA SHANK: Yes, thank you, Clay. I was praying about Arkansas, and I kept hearing this old song, Rock of Ages, Cleft for Me, but the Lord changed the first word from rock to ark. And He said:

Ark of Ages cleft for me. Let me hide myself in Thee. I heard the Lord say, I have hidden myself in the mountains of Arkansas. It will be a hiding place for the escapees from the spirit of the world. It will be a nesting place for reproduction of my character. It will be a resting place for the weary souls navigating the sea of life.

My voice will go forth from Arkansas to the nation. I see a tower, a communication tower, releasing the Word of God, releasing the decrees over the nation. My voice will echo from Arkansas. Arkansas will see what I saw and remove the see/saw from the playground of my church. I'm going to say that again: Arkansas will see what I saw and remove the see/saw from the playground of my church. It will not be a bitter word; it will be a better Word.

My Words that go forth from your territory will thunder against my enemies. The thunder will release the lightnings that strike the strongholds of the enemy. Jeremiah 1:9-10 "Then the Lord reached out his hand and touched my mouth and said to me, "I have put My words in your mouth. See, today I appoint you over nations and kingdoms to uproot and tear down, to destroy and overthrow, to build and plant."

I see, I saw, and I say, says the Lord. This is the way, walk in it. Arkansas will point the way to the victory, to the spoils of the victory, to the stolen treasures that Babylon carried away. The word is "Restore, Restore, Restore".

Arkansas, you are Nehemiah to Me. Spy it out. Do not listen to Tobiah or Sanballat. Their voices will be muted, but your voice will be amplified. Sing and rejoice Arkansas, My glory will be seen in your land. Strike up the band of brothers and sisters. Learn to harmonize and strategize. Ark of Ages cleft for me. Let me hide myself in thee.

So, Lord, we decree these things over Arkansas. Lord, what a great, great, glory is going to be seen from that nation. And the word will come forth from that state to the entire nation of America. So, Lord, we just release the thundering voice that You have from that state against Your enemies, and You will strike and release Your light over the strongholds of the enemy through the state of Arkansas. Amen.

CLAY NASH: Alright, Regina. Thank you for that. We come in agreement with it. I love the way the Lord put that word together in you and Pat to begin this call.

I want us to take moment and pray for Mary Bentley. She is a Representative here in the state; a very, very godly woman that is a true follower of Jesus, and she's supposed to be on the call, but she had to step in at 1:00 p.m. to present a bill, and she's working to do that properly, and then get free and come on the call. So, Father, bless Mary. Give her favor with this bill that she is presenting. We thank You, Father, for her heart for You, her heart for this state, her heart for families in this state. Touch her now, Father. Give her the words to release this which she is leading on the floor, and cause it to prevail and do so in Yeshua's Name. Amen. We're looking for her to come on and will bring her on later in the call.

I'm going to call on Charles and Nona Minyard, you're intercessors here in the state. Release some of things you're seeing, and you're praying about.

NONA MINYARD: I want to thank you, Clay, for giving me an opportunity to pray and come into agreement with all that's presented on this call. It is an honor for us to be involved in this. I'm a transplant. I'm Mississippi born, Tennessee raised but a transplant into Arkansas. And like you, Clay, I love this place. I want to thank you all who are on this call who have prayed day after day in support of what God is doing this. I thank you that you're over here today to support us in what we're doing with Arkansas. First of all, we want to pray for those who are in authority over us. The Word says, first of all, pray for them. We pray for those who are in authority over us, both in the state and in the nation. The Lord says, thank Him for them. For we thank Him for what He is doing through whomever is in that place of authority. We also want to thank Him for all He is doing in this state. He's moved mightily already, and we expect that He will move mightily again.

That being said, Father, you set Arkansas into the United States of America as the 25th state. Before the other states were even thought of or created. The 25th state of 50 states makes Arkansas the pivot point; the hinge pin of this nation. And Father, You saw fit to have Your servant, Chuck Pierce, decree not once, not twice, but three times: As

Goes Arkansas, so Goes the Nation. He decreed that from the south gate of Arkansas, El Dorado. He decreed it from the north gate, Eureka Springs. And he decreed it from the capitol state, Little Rock. I was a witness in all of those places. So by that authority, I decree, Arkansas to be the pivot point, the hinge pin to turn this nation back to God. We also decree that Arkansas is demonstrating God-given strategies within this state, patterns and principals for other states to use to bring their people, their land, and their government back to God. Arkansas, we declare and decree that the Gospel will be preached from all four corners and all the way into the center and back again, so that all people may hear the Gospel in a way that they've never heard it before and be given an opportunity to make Jesus Lord of their life. We decree that the church in Arkansas is awakening to its responsibility. It's a privilege and responsibility to legislate and to rule and reign in Your behalf, Father. We decree God's blessing hidden here in Arkansas in its people and in its land will be manifest to the glory of God. We decree that the ecclesia will arise to the places of influence in each of the seven mountains of culture. We decree that Arkansas will fulfill all its destiny, especially in turning this nation back to God. Father, we do thank You for all that You've done to restore Arkansas to its destiny. We thank You for pray-ers who have been raised up across this state. We're especially thankful for those that You have moved into this state, or moved back into this state, like Clay and Susan, to provide leadership and training, direction. We thank You for the Facebook group, Prayers that Make Diamonds. We declare Your word over the state of Arkansas. We thank You for Arkansas mappers. We thank You for end time handmaidens and servants. We thank You for all of the prayer groups in Arkansas, large and small, who are praying Your will, Father, into the state of Arkansas. That being said, we decree Thy kingdom come, Thy will be done in Arkansas. And we have no king, but Jesus.

CLAY NASH: Alright, thank you, Nona. Thank you for your leadership. Maybe if you're on the call in Arkansas, and you want to know more about Prayers that Make Diamonds, I'm going to make sure that Nona's email is on my website where you can go there and look it up. Claynash.org. You can contact her. It's a prayer force in the state of Arkansas, covering all 75 counties, all 85 county seats, where we can gather people together to pray for the issues within this state. Dwain Miller, I think you're on with us. I'd like for you to go next, and then I'm going to call on Sharon Buss after you.

DR. DWAIN MILLER: Yes sir, Apostle. It's an honor to be on with the great mighty warriors of God. I just want to remind everyone, most all of you know this, but if you're listening from other parts of the nation you may not know this, that one of the initial, if not the very initial outpourings of Holy Spirit on this nation occurred in Arkadelphia, Arkansas with a Southern Baptist pastor named William Jethro Wathaw (?) in 1879. It was September of 1879, long before Topeka, Kansas, Azusa Street and all the others. He was seeking God, reading the book of Acts when he was overwhelmed by the power of the Holy Ghost in the woods. When he woke up later he was praying in a language he did not know. From that event, he led 36 Southern Baptist churches into receiving

the Baptism of the Holy Spirit, with the evidence of speaking in tongues. That was in 1879 on into the early 1900's. As Holy Spirit was being pour out all over America from east to west coast and all through the center. One of my assignments for 25 years in the south gate of this state was to reopen that portal, or that ancient well that God had dug and had provided for this state. We had many, many meetings to do that, along with the great prayer assignments that Apostle Nash has led in bringing Apostle Dutch Sheets and Chuck Pierce. I was in the meeting in El Dorado when Chuck Pierce prophesy: As Goes Arkansas, so Goes the Nation. I said all that to say this, that is, God has reopened that ancient well in Arkansas, and the portals in this state are intensifying. Again, I remind you of something that I don't have time to develop fully, but one of my spiritual mentors, a great man of God, Dr. Marvin Gorman, had an open vision of great awakening coming to Arkansas and making its way from south Arkansas to central Arkansas to north Arkansas, where Clay lives fulfilling that prophetic word and dream and destiny of Corry Ten Boom on that property at the Ark. This move of God then moved over into southern Missouri/Oklahoma and made its way down into the Dallas area and in through central Texas into south Texas and back over to New Orleans. And just made a ring of fire in the heart of this state. I say all that to encourage us and to exhort us in the fact that the intercessors that are praying God's Word and decreeing God's will from heaven, you're making a difference. One every fourth Thursday night each month we have our Arkansas Miracle Hub at the Edge. Apostle Nash comes along with other leaders and we're seeing creative miracles, manifestations, people experiencing visitations of angels, healings. God is truly pouring out His Spirit here into this state, and it's only going to intensify. And on this day, a very strategic day in the Kingdom of Heaven as Passover has begun in God's land of Israel, Arkansas sits on a spiritual lay line between here and Israel. We are on the same 33rd parallel, and there's a divine connection between the heart of Arkansas and the heart of Israel. I tie all that together by praying and saying, Father in heaven, we know there is a divine supernatural destiny for this state that's greater and so far beyond the scope and realm of anything we've ever seen or experienced, beyond anything we've touched, felt or discerned. That we open up our heart, we humble ourself before You. We repent of the sins of our forefathers, we thank You that the curses that have been brought to this state have been divinely broken with the acts of repentance and renewal and restoration of Apostle Nash and his prayer teams as that demonic force of the Masonic by Albert Pike has been torn down; has been cancelled. The spirit of Leviathan has been destroyed. We thank You that his demonic soul-tie that this state had with Kabal and the deep state has been severed. That there has been a revival and an awakening in this state politically. That finally, there are no abortions in this state. There will never be again. Life has been spared. Life has been restored. Now our children in our schools, in our families are being protected from the demonic forces of hell that would come to destroy them, and remove their identity. I thank You, Lord, that You have raised up a governor who is in love with Jesus and in love with the family. And I thank You that You've raised up legislators in this state, like Mary and the previous senator, Jason Rapport, and many others who are emboldened on the front line to make sure that God, His Word,

His Spirit and family is intact in this state. And we declare that from the Word of God, that the righteous now rule so there is no mourning in this state. We decree that As Goes Arkansas, so Goes the Washington, D.C. and the rest of this nation. And just as You have exposed, and You have uncovered, and You have arrested, indicted and removed crooked politicians and people that are in criminal conduct that held this state back for years, just as You have done that in this state, You are doing that in the United States of America.

And the Lord says, "Watch and see". After yesterday, the Lord says, "Watch and see". In the news there will be something significant that will come forth very soon. In this season of Passover, going from captivity to conquest, as there will be a major event. There will be a major exposure. Something that will shake this nation to its core. The Lord says, I am doing this thing, and I am returning the fear of the Lord to this nation. Just as the fear of the Lord has returned back to the state of Arkansas, and continues to intensify and grow, the Lord said, I am going to do something that will expose and will reveal so that My people will know that all that has happened has been done as Pat prayed, so that this kingdom that cannot be shaken will manifest not only in Arkansas, but in every state in this nation, and will bring about a great awakening in the United States of America. Let it be so, in Yeshua's Name. Amen.

CLAY NASH: Amen. Thank you, Dwain, for that. That information that you released is so pertinent to this state and to the nation. Remind everyone, I had a dream the end of 2021 about a pipeline being built from Texas to D.C. And it had to come through Hot Springs, Arkansas. The pipeline was also to flow olive oil to D.C. It was very important in Arkansas' place of responsibility.

CLAY NASH: Go ahead, Sharon.

SHARON BUSS: Thank you so much, Clay. It's a pleasure to be here again today. I'm so moved by what has already been brought today. I want to add to it how amazing it is as we look at hot spots all over the world where the demonic has tried to do things. It's because of the call of God that's on a place. Like how Fort Smith was used and Albert Pike was operating here in Arkansas, and so on. It's other things that have gone on in dirty dealings in Arkansas. But it's because that they're just trying to keep a lid on what God has intended. All of the prayer and mapping and decreeing and staking and redeeming that has gone on in Arkansas is releasing the power and the glory. As I was praying about this call this morning, I saw the map of Arkansas and I had the understand and the impression that it is like a plow blade. That God is going to use Arkansas to do a plowing in His garden. I began to think about the Mississippi being our eastern border. The first explorers that came here, the Spanish, called the Mississippi River, which is called The Great River by the local people. The Spaniards came and called it The River of the Holy Spirit. That is our eastern border. I looked up the word east in the Scriptures. The first place that it appears is that God planted a garden eastward in Eden. There is something very significant about the garden of God in Arkansas, and what He wants to do. One of the next places that east appears is where

the cherubim are guarding the way of the Tree of Life after Adam and Eve have been tossed out of the east side of Eden. Something's significant there. The local Indians of that area, the Quapaw, where the Spanish and the French were encountering as they came to explore in this land. Those people were known by others as The People of the South Wind. That's where the name Arkansas comes from. When the French first made a settlement here, it's now called Arkansas post, it was six Frenchmen and a hut, and they called it Ozarks. It was named for the people, the Quapaw people and their name that came down from the Algonquian and the Ohio River Valley people. So, they're the Southwind people. So, we have east, and we have south. The fact that it's called Ozarks, our dear friend, Clay's friend as well as ours, Francine Lovell, a French woman from Paris, when she came here she said Ozarks is, and the name Arkansas as well, in French the word rainbow is Arc-en-ziel. The Ozarks, in her view of it, is Of the Rainbow. I'm saying that because in Scripture you see a lot of wordplay, if you understand the original languages. There's a lot of wordplay going on that doesn't translate into English when we read the Scripture. I believe God loves wordplay and He has declared over Arkansas that this is a place of His glory. We see in Ezekiel 1:28 Amplified "As the appearance of the rainbow in the clouds on a rainy day so was the appearance of the surrounding radiance. This was the appearance of the likeness of the glory and brilliance of the Lord." So, the glory has the appearance of a rainbow. That's also mentioned in the Book of Revelation a couple of times where the rainbow was around the throne. I believe the Lord has a plan to pour out His glory in this land. I also want to comment about the tornados that we've been having recently in particular. There have been lots of tornados that have ripped through Arkansas that have done amazing, horrible things. I believe that God wants to do is make a statement that the tornados that are showing up are the devil's version of the pillar of cloud and the pillar of fire, that is of the presence of the Lord. So, that's his attempt to try and do things that are contrary to what the Lord has planned. I want to declare the ripping of the veil of deception off people's minds in the same way that these horrible whirlwinds have ripped roofs and all sorts of things off houses. We're declaring a tearing and a breaking down of the demonic and of the agenda of the darkness as the light of the glory of our heavenly Father is being revealed in this state, in His glory. His glory is being poured out and we declare the outpouring of the Lord Jesus Christ. The outpouring of the Holy Spirit. The outpouring of the presence of God. That transforms people's hearts and minds. That they're going to simply wake up as this veil of deception is being ripped off their minds. That they will be able to see the glory of God. That they will be turned in their hearts to our glorious Father. And that they will come into the full fellowship of the glory of the outpouring. Even as the outpouring, the people that experienced outpouring, came together in Hot Springs, Arkansas to form the first Pentecostal denomination, The Assemblies of God, happened herein Arkansas. We declare a renewing and that that being a first fruits of the harvest that's coming into this state. And As Goes Arkansas, So Goes the Nation. In the name of Jesus Christ. Amen.

CLAY NASH: Alright, thank you, Sharon, for that. We come into agreement. Representative Bentley, I think you're on with us now. Mary, number one, thank you for the battle that you keep presenting so that the very presence of God can totally engulf this state. We pray for you all the time, but I want to thank you for that. We hear you and we want you to release your heart about what's going on in Arkansas, so we can come in agreement with it.

REPRESENTATIVE MARY BENTLEY: I want to thank you again for your daily commitment to prayer. It's just so heartwarming to know that so many people are faithfully praying. Your team especially has blessed me immensely. So, just thank you all for that. I'll tell you quickly how the atmosphere has changed in this capitol with this governor. It's hard to describe it, but it's a whole new day and a whole new chapter for Arkansas. I'm very excited about everything that's gone on here. We've passed a number of great bills to protect children, to protect the family and to move our state forward. Thank you all so much for your prayers. I'll now just pray and let you guys agree with me if that's fine, Clay?

Father, I thank You for Your faithfulness to this state. And thank You for blessing us with a godly governor that knows You and loves you. Father, thank You for what You're doing here in Arkansas. Thank You for the amazing things have moved; things You have accomplished this session. We thank You for bringing godly men and women here to the state capitol. Thank You for people that were faithful to vote and to get these people in office, and to surround them with prayer. I know, Lord, that we have prayer groups across the state that're coming together to make this state what You want it to be. Father for Your will and for Your favor to be on every bill that's come across the desk here and voted by our governor. Father, we thank You for all that You're doing right now. Father, we thank You for the words that were given forth today. Father, thank You for prophets that give us vision and lead us forward. Father, I thank You for the apostolic that's here today to lead us forward as well. I thank You for all that You're doing now. Father, I thank You that You are bringing Arkansas right in alignment during this Passover season where it needs to be to move forward to her destiny. Lord, I thank You for continuing to bring revival here in Arkansas. Lord, I don't know all that You have planned for this state, but I thank You for pastors coming forward that need to as well, Father, for us to align and get the outpouring in this state. That You need to fill Your purpose and Your will in the Kingdom hour that we're in right now. Father, thank You for Your light and Your salt that's coming forth in all the legislators that are here as they leave and disperse across the state, that what began here will continue to spread across the state in our counties, in our city level, all across Arkansas, and in the congregations in this world and in the ecclesia that's here will continue to be the salt and the light that You've called Arkansas to be. Lord, we thank You and we praise You for all You are doing here in Yeshua's Name. Amen.

CLAY NASH: Alright. Thank you, woman of God, we appreciate your leadership so. You're part of our daily prayers, and all the representatives here. We are very, very

thankful for your godly stand for this state. It is affecting the nation, and I believe it's fulfilling the word from February the 24th, 2004; As Goes Arkansas, so Goes the Nation. So, God bless you. Also have on the call today a great friend of mine, also a pastor in the state, but rising up in leadership in the state of Arkansas, Iverson Jackson. So, my friend, come on and release those things that are in your heart.

IVERSON JACKSON: Thank you for being on, and for all those that have been praying and are praying, and Pastor Dwain and our very dear friend, Representative Bentley, what a dear, dear woman of God she is. And I can tell you she lives the life that you heard her pray about. I just want to thank God for all of that. Brother Clay, I just want to share briefly and then pray. My prayer, what I'm believing God for, what is happening is that we pull down and root up that last vestige of bitterness between races in this state that's being perpetuated by older generations poisoning the younger generations. We have to come against that root, because God is doing such a powerful thing in this state in bringing people together across every line that the enemy could set up, and people's hearts just melting into one. I know that the Word of God is so powerful that in that place where the tree and the root of bitterness was, that we can root that up, and there'll be a beautiful tree growing that will have beautiful fruit on it. That fruit will be able to seed future generations with it. I want to go before the Lord on their behalf because that has no place in the kingdom of God. Arkansas is going to lead the way. Just as we're known from what happened in 1957 with the Little Rock Nine, we'll be known as the nation that birthed the nine gifts of the Spirit; that it just burst across this whole nation. So, Father, we just come before You today to give You thanksgiving and praise for the leadership on this call. Lord, for all those that You have set in places strategically in governments, in churches, in businesses. In every place in our society You have set Your generals, You have set Your lieutenants, You have set Your people there for this strategic time in history as You have set Arkansas at just about the center of this nation. So, Father, I just want to thank You as we bind ourselves together in covenant prayer for this state, the state of Arkansas, this great state. The wonderful history that we've heard has been uncovered in this time of prayer, Lord, we take that in and we thank You. And we can see Your hand upon this state moving throughout the generations and throughout the centuries because You have set us apart for such a time as this to bring this nation back into love with You. And so, Father, we declare that we stand as representatives of Arkansas, and we say that we love You, Father, and we honor You, and we fear You because You said this is the whole duty of man to fear You and to keep Your commandments. We say with humble hearts, Lord, as we say, maybe not in our postures on bended knees, but in our hearts, Lord, in our hearts our knees are bended for You, and our arms are raised before You, to say we love You and we praise You and we thank You. We stand in agreement for Your will to be poured out and Your way and Your Holy Spirit to fill this state again and let it go out from this state, Lord, and fill this nation again. And, Lord, we say that God bless America, and America God. We give You all the praises, and we give You all the glory, and we thank You that that root of bitterness has been yanked out of this state, Lord God, and thrown into the fires hell where it belongs. In that place this beautiful tree that will produce fruit from every heart.

And, Lord, we'll be able see future generations and we'll just thank You. We call Your love to permeate this great land that You have given us that we call Arkansas. Every ounce, we won't give up one blade of grass to the enemy. Not one grain of sand will we give. We won't give him any place in Arkansas. We're not satisfied to have the house, and the senate, and the governorship, but, Lord, we won't be satisfied until every soul hears the word of God and comes to a knowledge of and a relationship with You. We give You the praise. We give You the glory. We thank You for our leader, Apostle Clay Nash and all those that are grabbing the plow and plowing along with him, Lord. We thank You for all this. We bless You and we praise You in Jesus Name. Amen, Amen, Amen.

CLAY NASH: Thank you, Iverson, we appreciate it. Will you quickly tell us about your newly appointed position that Governor Sanders has appointed you to so the people will hear and be praying for you?

IVERSON JACKSON: Governor Huckabee Sanders appointed me to be the Executive Director of the Arkansas Fair Housing Commission. That commission was signed into law by none other than Governor Mike Huckabee in 2003. In August of this year, we'll be celebrating 20 years of the Arkansas Fair Housing Commission. We're hoping to have Governor Sanders there, if she can and Governor Huckabee. In this position, if there's housing discrimination on what's called the seven federal protected classes, that's what we handle. A lot of times people confuse us with Housing Authority, but that's now what we do. We try to make right if someone's been discriminated against because they're in one of those seven protected classes: race, color, religion, national origin, familial status or disability. I told them when they asked me if I wanted to do it, that I want to be in a place where I can serve people, and that sounded like it. So, that's why I accepted that. And I'm thankful to the governor for keeping me in mind for that position. It's a good place to be. Righting whatever we can to make people whole again.

CLAY NASH: Thank you. Congratulations. We're glad you're in there. I believe it's another step for you as you rise up in leadership in the state of Arkansas. Jacquie Tyre, I believe you have a prophetic word. You couldn't be on at the beginning, but we want to hear that word now. We'll call on Brother Jim Hodges after you.

JACQUIE TYRE: Alright, Clay, I am so honored to be on. I was on and able to listen, but I wasn't where I could speak early on. Before I release this work, I want to say I come from a musical background in some of my training. Some of the imagery that God used in this word took me back to having a piano tuner come into our home, to tune our piano. I want say this as I give this word, I hear such an increase of the tuning of the Lord in Arkansas, across Arkansas. From years and years and years ago when there was a dissonance. God has been tuning and retuning, and there's a beautiful sound coming. This morning, as I was spraying for this call, I very clearly heard the Lord say: As a master tuner tunes a piano, so I have been working to tune and retune Arkansas to reflect My sound into the earth. With each new tuning, I have been recalibrating my people, their mindsets, their belief systems, practices, habits, expectations and

alignment to move without hindrance or dissonance in the days ahead. Where things have gone flat or dull over the years, I have been adjusting, calibrating and tuning to bring the sound of Arkansas out of the old and into the new. Out of religious traditions of man and into the movement of My Kingdom. What was once in tune by use and staying in the same old, same old, without regular tunings grew flat and dull requiring multiple steps and processes to bring the sound progressively back in tune with Me without slipping back into the old. There are still some steps to go through to bring all in tune with My sound but know that My hands are on the pins ready to tune in just the right ways so that the dissonance is resolved and that the clarity of the sounds of heaven can come forth with purity even to be used as a basis for others to be tuned to in days ahead. Know My tuning and My process, though at times seems slow, laborious and even monotonous, is mandatory for the process to be completed with success and effectiveness for the future. Don't fear or shrink back from the passing dissonance with the strings around you for this, too, is only a part of the process to bring all the strings, all the streams into tune with My sound out of heaven.

So, Father, I thank You that Your hands are upon the pins holding the strings and the streams across Arkansas. To bring them into a perfect harmony, into a perfect tuning with the sounds of heaven. Lord, I thank You for what You have done over the years to bring Arkansas from one place to another to another to another. In a progressive aligning with heaven. And I decree, Father, that what You have begun You shall complete. What You have released as Your sound that is causing the aligning of the sounds of heaven to be brought, and the sounds of earth. And, Father, I pray for those places where there is dissonance at the moment, where the sound is still rooted in the old, that Your hand, and your strength, and Your gentleness will fine tune every portion so that the sound that comes out of Arkansas, we decree that it will be in tune, perfectly calibrated with the sounds of heaven to become that basis for the tuning of that which is around them, even across this nation. Father, establish Your sound in and through and out of Arkansas. For Your glory, and your honor. In the mighty name of Jesus. Amen.

CLAY NASH: Alright Jacquie, thank you. I have a real great friend here that is a piano tuner here in the state of Arkansas. We've been friends for years. I'm going to get that word to him and get him to give me some insight to some of it, because that's definitely a word for this state. Brother Jim Hodges, it is so good to have you on. What's in your heart, sir?

JIM HODGES: Thank you, Apostle Clay. Two hours before the call, I heard this simple phrase, but wow have I gotten definition and revelation being on this call from these who've shared. The word I had was simply: Arkansas is Ascending. I knew nothing about Dutch's word in 2015 or Chuck's words. I knew nothing really about the history that Apostle Dwaine Miller took forth. None of that was in my brain, as it were when I heard all that. And even Sharon talked about the Assemblies of God, the history there, which I did know, but it spoken with an anointing. It caused things out of the past to start exploding. You talk about digging wells, the dirt's gone and the wells are rising up

beyond the ground level. The, of course, we rejoice the main _(?)_ concerning our rejoicing for this has to do with the election of your Governor Sarah Huckabee Sanders. Interesting just a footnote, I really enjoyed Mike Huckabee. I was really for him and for Ted Cruz because I knew they both knew the Lord. By the way, I did vote for Trump, for what that's worth. But I will say I believe it was the Lord's will that Trump be the man then. Mike Huckabee, all he did as the governor, pastor of a Baptist church, that's my background. There is a new move coming upon the entire body of Christ in the state, but it will be, shall I say, modeled and exemplified, if not using the word led, by the Baptists and the Assemblies of God. That's just like the Lord, isn't it, to bring His body together. Because my background's Baptist and the Assemblies of God treated me well many, many years ago, I'm that old when the Baptist's no longer felt led that I should leave then. So, I'm excited about that. What's going on. Then I thought about this, Arkansas, and then you've got the state named Kansas. Most of us would agree, I think this is accurate, that Kansas is the geographical heartland. I believe the Lord is going to make Arkansas the spiritual heartland. And I'm excited about what's going on. Arkansas, in a similar way is like Kansas; it's circled by many states. We know it's not on the right coast or the left coast. We sure know that. Although the river to the east, the Mississippi's so big it sure seems like a coast. I'm happy to pray into Arkansas in a new way. After all, that's a neighbor of mine; I'm a Texan. I'm headed there New Boston, Texas, which is a stone's throw from Texarkana. Hello, at the end of this month to minister.

So, Father, we thank You for what You're doing across our nation. We thank You that Arkansas is ascending; it's rising. As it does so, there's a releasing of that sound that Jacquie prophesied because You're arresting us, Lord, not just only by the revelation of Your Word, and the Word of the Kingdom in this hour, but You're arresting us by sounds released from heaven that will change the earth. Sounds not yet heard here will be heard here in this present and ongoing and sustained and continued Jesus movement. And we say the movement of the Holy Ghost has now come forth with great momentum, and these momentum times will be caused by special moments which we have with You and we have with each other as a corporate ecclesia. In the name of Yeshua. Amen

CLAY NASH: Alright, thank you Brother Jim Hodges. We come in agreement with those words of declaration and decree. David Hertel, there in Mississippi, what's in your heart.

DAVID HERTEL: Yes, sir. Just agreeing with Brother Jim and the move of the Holy Spirit, and the prayers that have been prayed, the one sister mentioned diamonds, and another one said something about the plow blade. I was remembering where Arkansas can claim what no other state has claim to, is the largest American diamond was found there in 1924. It was uncut 42.3 karats, and it's called the Uncle Sam, which is interesting because it's the nickname of the guy that found it. Proverbs 17:18 came to mind. It says, As a present is a precious stone in the eyes of possessor, wherever he turns he prospers. So we declare in Jesus name, Arkansas you are a gift, a present to Uncle Sam. You are to this nation as a precious stone, as a diamond. You were given for such a time as this to call and to cause this nation to turn to Jehovah, God honor his

covenant, and prosper and the fulfilling of its destiny as one nation under God. One nation sending the Gospel of the Kingdom to the shores of the rest of this world. We claim Arkansas will be a sharp, two-edged sword, like a plow blade in the Lord's hand for the establishing and the advancing of His kingdom in every system of influence of America. And we'll give You the glory and the honor and the praise, Lord, as You bring it about. In Jesus name, Amen.

CLAY NASH: Amen. Thank you, David for that. I prophesied about a diamond find in 2015 and the lady who discovered it, I'm not going to try to pronounce it, but the name that she chose in Spanish was actually Hope. I prophesied that there would be a diamond and that it would be a sign that God was bring right in the midst of the trail of hope was bring hope to the state. And a diamond was found. I don't remember how big a karat. The lady chose the Spanish word for hope. Alright, we're to the end of the call. I'll call on a pastor out of Bentonville, Gary Williams, and have you close us in prayer today. Thank you for being on.

PASTOR GARY WILLIAMS: Alright. Thank you, Clay. Let me say thank you to all of you. I think it was Nona who said she was not a native from Arkansas. We've been here since '99, and just part of this group for the last year or so. I feel like the 11th hour laborer that gets to lock arms, and we're privileged and honored, us and our church here, to lock arms with ya'll, and pray for our state and our nation, and to be involved with ya'll. We're appreciative, we're thankful for Clay. We recognize the apostolic call on his life, the gift and the calling and how he administers that with humility. We're blessed and honored to be part of you all. I'll say that to say this, I just left our men's prayer group at noon today. I had this strong sense that we were in there praying for our state and our governor and the Lord was saying that maybe He wants me to encourage you all, which you already know that He's hearing your prayers. It was like this pressure inside me that was being released. I felt like the Lord said to me, If an earthly Father knows how to give good gifts, how much more do you think I'm going to give you? And I'm going to give you all that have been praying for so long the state of Arkansas. I believe He's doing that. I want to pray into that, then I want to read Psalms 22. It's interesting how Dr. Hodges is on the call because I'm using his message from the NEI Conference in December, and we're learning about imprecatory prayers. We're starting to develop those. Dr. Hodges, thank you for that. Let's go to the Lord in prayer. Father, first of all, we want to say we love You. You are amazing. We're thankful that because of Jesus' sacrifice that we can be sons and daughters. And that we can come to You and we can ask. You said we can ask anything and You're going to do it. So we believe right now that You are giving us the State of Arkansas. It is returning to You. That common sense is coming back. Some of it is even self-preservation. They understand that Your ways serve them better. And they may not even be believers. But we thank You that You are answering those prayers right now. So, we bless You. We're so thankful for our governor. We thank You for Representative Bentley that her testimony that has changed the atmosphere in the capitol. So, Lord we pray that You continue. That You pour out Your grace and Your mercy and Your blessing on us and on

our state, Lord. We want to represent You well. We pray that this state is turning back to You. That it's going to be an amazing thing. So, we bless You and we honor You, Lord. I want to read these Scriptures to end prophetically today out of Psalms 22, the last 7-8 verses.

I will praise You in the great assembly. I will fulfill my vows in the presence of those who worship You. The poor will even be satisfied. All who seek the Lord will praise Him. Their hearts will rejoice with everlasting joy. The whole earth will acknowledge the Lord and return to Him. All the families of the nations will bow down before Him. For royal power belongs to the Lord. He rules all the nations. Let the rich of the earth feast and worship, bow before Him. All who are mortal, all whose lives will end as dust. Our children, yes our children will also serve Him. Future generations will hear about the wonders of the Lord. His righteous acts will be told to those yet to be born. They will hear about everything He has done.

So, Father, we seal this with that. Arkansas is laying a foundation, turning back to you. And our children and our grandchildren will testify of Your mighty works and Your mighty power in the state of Arkansas. So, we seal this with the power of the Holy Spirit and in agreement. In Jesus Name I pray. Amen and Amen.

CLAY NASH: Alright, thank you, Gary. You ended your prayer and your call at 2:22. This call went for an hour. I find it interesting it stopped at the 2:22 mark. Alright, tomorrow we'll be praying for Maryland. On Friday we're going to finish this strong week with Virginia. Join with us tomorrow at 2:22 and again on Friday. God bless you all.
