

My Testimony

I rejoice with a joy unspeakable. This joy, full of glory received unto faith, even the work of salvation of our souls because I have been redeemed. I have been redeemed by the precious blood of Jesus who is without spot and without blemish. I've been born again, not of corruptible seed but an incorruptible seed, which is the Word of God that lives and abides forever. Jesus Christ, You are my cornerstone. You are the living stone.

Jesus, You were rejected by men, chosen of God, and You are precious. I'm a lively stone that makes up a spiritual house, a holy priesthood. I'm ready to offer up spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Christ Jesus. Hallelujah, I'm a chosen generation, a chosen people. I'm a royal priesthood, a holy priesthood. I'm a peculiar person that shows forth praises unto You, who led me out of darkness. You have led me out of the darkness, into your kingdom. You did so by Your beloved son, Jesus Christ, through whom I have redemption and have forgiveness of ALL, ALL, ALL my sins.

I'm telling You, I love You and I praise Your name. Oh, the riches of glory in inheritance for those who choose to be chosen. Exceeding riches of His glory are to me, who has chosen to believe,

according to the workings of His mighty power. Praise Your name, Lord. O God, You perform, in Jesus, Your works when You raised Him from the dead.

I will not be conformed to this world. I will not walk, talk, or act like this world. I'm transformed by the renewing of my mind. And I not only know, but I prove what is the good, perfect, and acceptable will of God. Praise Your name! Praise Your character, Your authority, and Your nature. I rejoice greatly in You, my God. I rejoice greatly in You, my Lord.

I declare the glad tidings of Your righteousness to the great congregation. Your Good News shall be heard from my lips. Behold, I will not restrain my lips, O God.
